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# Section A - Setting up the iQ 30 Cart.

## STEP 1 - Opening the iQ 30 Cart.

Swing the handle to unlock the sliding top.




Slide the top to open.



STEP 2 - Routing the cables.

Remove the Carry Baskets.



Undo the thumbwheels on the internal shelves.



Remove the mats.



Remove the 4 shelves by lifting on the pull-hole.



# STEP 2 - Routing the cables continued...

Lay the shelves on a scratch-proof surface.



Insert all the device cables into the USB ports.



# **ENSURE BOTH IQ SYNC CHARGE BOXES ARE SWITCHED ON**

Run the cable up through the hole at the end.



Pull the cable through the center Gripweld. Slide the cable along adjacent to the device.



Pass the cable end through the center Gripweld.



Replace the shelves and insert thumbwheels.



## STEP 3 - Devices ready for syncing and charging.


Insert all your devices in the Carry Baskets and place back into the iQ 30 Cart.



Unwind the power cable and plug into the wall socket.



Connecting to a Macbook: Plug in the host cable(s) into the Host port(s) and connect to the Macbook.



Plug the device cable end into the device.



When not used, wrap excess cable around the cable cleat.



For security, close the sliding lid, swing the handle closed and lock the pad-lock. The devices can be charged with the sliding lids closed.



Follow the additional instructions for the iQ 16 Sync Charge Box supplied, for operation of the syncing and charging functions.

# Section B - Setting up the Security Chain Kit.

## Tools required:

- · Masonry hammer-drill
- 10mm masonry drill bit
- Pencil and ruler/tape
- Hammer
- 13mm and 17mm spanners

## The Security Chain Kit contains the following:

- 1 x 3 holed Anchor Plate and security chain
- 3 x 55mm long, 8mm Anchor Bolts
- 3 x Shear Nuts and washers
- 1 x Lock and key set

Move the Trolley to where you intend to store and secure it. It is best if the Floor Plate is as close as possible to a wall to reduce the hazard of tripping and injury.

Attach the end of the chain to the steel loop with the padlock and position the plate end in the desired position on the floor.

(NOTE: If mounting on carpet you will need to cut out the carpet from the area where the floor plate attaches, otherwise the carpet will wrap around the drill when drilling).

Mark the center of each of the 3 holes, using the floor plate as a guide.

of the 3 marked centers to a depth of 50mm.

Insert the anchor bolts with nut attached into the holes through the floor plate. Using the 13 mm spanner, progressively tighten down each of these anchor nuts so that all three bolts are firmly anchored into the concrete.





Drill a 10mm hole through each



Now undo each of the three nuts, and in their place thread on the three silver shear-nuts. Ensure that the 'cone' is down and the hexagonal nut is up. Using the 17mm spanner tighten down the three shear nuts until the hexagonal 'head' shears off, leaving just the cone 'base'.

Attach the security chain through the steel loop under the side of the trolley using the padlock.





## **Troubleshooting**

- If no lights are illuminated with the iQ 16 Sync Charge Box is switched ON, check that the power cable
  is fully inserted into the iQ 16 Sync Charge Box socket and the other end is fully inserted into the mains
  power socket and the mains power switch is ON.
- 2. To check the iQ 16 Sync Charge Box is operating correctly, switch the iQ 16 Sync Charge Box OFF. Remove all connected USB cables and switch back ON again. Both the Charge light and the Sync light should initially illuminate but the Sync light will extinguish after a short delay. This is normal operation.
- If the iQ 16 Sync Charge Box is operating normally but the devices cannot be charged, check the USB cables connecting to the devices are of the correct type and quality and not damaged.
- 4. If the iQ 16 Sync Charge Box is operating normally but the devices cannot be synchronized, check the USB cables connecting to the devices are of the correct type and quality and not damaged.
- Any other issues relating to synchronization problems should be referred to your IT department or provider of synchronization software.

#### Warranty
