Printed articles made from LOCTITE® 3D 3860™ exhibit high heat deflection temperature (HDT) and good print resolution, LOCTITE® 3D 3860™ is a low viscosity liquid that is printable at room temperature across various Laser SLA and DLP Platforms.

TYPICAL CURING PERFORMANCE

LOCTITE[®] 3D 3860[™] can be cured by exposure to ultraviolet and/or visible light of sufficient intensity and wavelength. Cure rate and ultimate depth of cure depend on light intensity, spectral distribution of the light source, exposure time and light transmittance of the printer window through which the light

LOCTITE® 3D 3860™ will cure with DLP and Lasers ranging from 300 to 450 nm.

- 4. Do not leave resin in printer tray when not in use.
- 5. Post print processing, rinse the printed part using an approved cleaner to remove uncured resin.
