OneTouch AT Software Update Instructions

Update Locally Using a Flash Drive

To update using a flash drive, you must have physical access to your OneTouch.

- 1. Download the OneTouch AT software from the <u>Downloads</u> page onto a PC.
- 2. Copy the .img file onto a USB flash drive or an SD RAM card.
- 3. Connect the USB flash drive or SD RAM card to your OneTouch AT.
- 4. Tap the TOOLS button, and then, under the **Maintenance Tools** heading, select **Update Software**.
- 5. Tap usbstorage or sdcard.
- 6. Tap the .img file name.
- 7. Tap **OK** on the bottom right corner of the screen.
- 8. Confirm the update version number, and tap **OK** again to install the new software.

Update Remotely Using Link-Live and Remote Control

Link-Live Cloud Service is a free, online system for viewing, tracking, and organizing your test results. Link-Live also allows you to remote connect to and control your OneTouch.

- 1. Connect your OneTouch AT to a network via the management port. See **TOOLS > Maintenance Tools > Management Port** on your OneTouch to check the management port connection.
- 2. Next, claim your device in Link-Live if you have not already:
 - a. Create an account at <u>Link-Live.com</u> using a web browser, or if you already have an account, sign in.
 - b. If you are a new Link-Live user, a pop-up box appears automatically and prompts you to claim a device. Otherwise, click the **Units** icon in the left menu pane, and then, click the **Claim Unit** button at the lower left corner of the page.
 - c. In the Link-Live Claim Unit pop-up box, select the OneTouch AT image.
 - d. Follow the on-screen instructions to finish claiming.
- 3. To remotely control and transfer the OneTouch AT software to the OneTouch AT, click on the **Units** icon on the left menu pane to go to the Units page.
- 4. Locate the OneTouch AT unit you want to update from the list of claimed devices.
- Click on the green cloud icon to open the Cloud Remote window.
 NOTE: If the cloud icon is gray , check to see that the TOOLS > Link-Live Cloud Tools > Cloud Remote: setting on the OneTouch AT is On and the OneTouch AT management port is accessible via the Internet.
- 6. Select the **Remote Files** tab at the top of the remote window.



- 7. Select **internal/**, **sdcard/**, or **USBstorage/** for the location where you want the new software to be stored on your OneTouch device.
- 8. Click on the drop down menu at the bottom of the screen, and select **Software Update**.
- 9. Browse for the location of the OneTouch AT software to transfer and click **Open** to start the transfer. When the rolling bar stops, the transfer is complete. It may take a few minutes.
- 10. To update the OneTouch AT software, select the **Remote Control** tab.
- 11. On the OneTouch AT home screen, click the TOOLS button , and then, under the **Maintenance Tools** heading, select **Update Software**.
- 12. Navigate to the **.img** file on your OneTouch AT, and select it.
- 13. Click **OK** on the bottom right corner of the screen.
- 14. Confirm the update version number, and click **OK** again to install.

The OneTouch will install the update and restart. Installation may take several minutes.
