

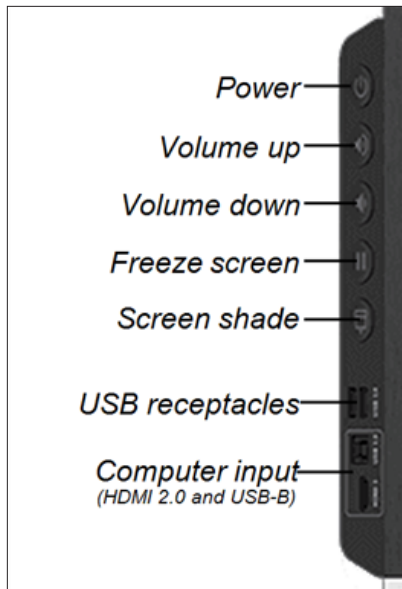
SMART Board® 6000S

Need some help with your display?
Check out these basic troubleshooting tips.



Turn on the display

Press the Power button on the convenience panel:



OR

Pick up a pen or the eraser.


Tool Explorer™

The display features the Tool Explorer platform, which enables you to use other SMART-authorized pens and tools in addition to those supplied with the display. No additional configuration is required: just pick up a pen or tool and start using it.

Show the connected computer's desktop

After connecting a computer, tap the Home button below the screen:



Tap **Input** , and then tap the computer's thumbnail:



Note: Be sure to enable touch control of your computer by connecting a USB cable from the computer to the appropriate USB-B receptacle on the display.

Use the iQ features

The display includes iQ features that you can use without connecting a computer. To access these features, tap the Home button below the screen:
