
Quick Start Guide



Getting to Know Your Sound System

Make note of the location of the speakers and ceiling sensor in your classroom. Ensure that you have unpacked and charged your battery-powered microphones. Keep this guide handy for future reference.



- 1. Speakers
- 2. Ceiling Sensor
- 3. Wireless Microphones
- 4. Microphone battery charger
- 5. Receiver/Amplifier

STEP 1. USING THE AMPLIFIER/RECEIVER

1. Power & Status Indicator


- · Red: OFF
- · Blue: ON and activated
- · Amber: STANDBY

2. Mic Channels/Volume Controls

- Green light: Microphone on and connected to channel
- No light: Microphone is not on; and/or sensor is not plugged in; and/or sensor is not receiving mic signal

3. Input Volume Controls

 Controls volume of connected external devices



4. Input Jack and Volume Control

· Connects additional external devices to the system (ex. iPhone or mp3 player)

5. Output Volume Control and Output Jack

· Connects devices for recording lessons
