


IntelliCenter offers a stable and dependable income stream with 8.7 years of weighted average lease term remaining - providing income stability through any near-term recessionary environment.

EDUCATION




Gwinnett County Public Schools is the largest school system in Georgia and the 15th largest in the Nation. The GCPS serves nearly 180,000 students across 139 schools. Seventeen schools have been recognized as National Blue Ribbon Schools and the district has won the prestigious Broad Foundation prize on two occasions (2010 & 2014).

The School system is one of the largest drivers for business moving to the Area. Top ranked public schools are conveniently located for decision makers and workforce talent alike anywhere in Gwinnett County, even more so in the Sugarloaf / Duluth area of Gwinnett County.



To support the targeted (and now approved) research and technology growth, the Georgia DOT has completed or are in the midst of 31 reconstruction projects along SR-316 from Atlanta to Athens through Gwinnett, Oconee, and Barrow County. The need for these projects is based on the existing and future traffic congestion along this growing corridor. Once completed, the changes will upgrade sections of SR-316 to a freeway-style corridor, improve traffic flow conditions and connect Athens and the University of Georgia to Atlanta.
