The Shaffer MacCartney Building is the second of 2 adjacent buildings spanning 332,000 SF. The state-owned facility is designed to train the workforce and foster innovation and connectivity among the cybersecurity community. The building's ribbon cutting took place on January 10, 2019 and houses a cyber incubator. Space is available for lease.

The Hull McKnight Building has delivered and currently houses the School of Computer and Cyber Sciences at Augusta University, Augusta Technical College, the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) Cyber Crime lab, Parsons, Defense Digital Service, BAE, the Clubhou.se, and Buona Caffè, as well as cyber training for State of Georgia employees across various departments. Space is available for lease.
