





Battersea Square

The pedestrianised Battersea Square combines internationally renowned dining, such as London House by Gordon Ramsay, with neighbourhood establishments like Queenswood or the delightful Gail's bakery. Restaurant terraces extend onto the square, where diners enjoy al fresco dining in the summer months.

Clapham Junction

More than a transport hub, Clapham Junction is a thriving destination for neighbourhood bars and restaurants. The plant-filled Minnow was named one of the best lunch spots in Clapham, while Ben's Canteen offers a relaxed neighbourhood hangout serving brunches and dinner in a beautiful interior. More favourites include the modern French Sinabro or the intimate Counter Culture, offering local ingredients with a slant towards all things pickled and fermented.

Wandsworth

Wandsworth is known for its charm, and no establishment better exemplifies this than The Ship, a riverside pub and local landmark since the late 18th century. Not far away, Brinkley's Kitchen offers a contemporary dining experience and a spacious bar overlooking the verdant Wandsworth Common.





RAD – a globally renowned dance education and training organisation – have recently re-located to Battersea. A quarter of a million dancers around the world have trained under its rigorous classical ballet syllabus; the brightest graduates go on to principal positions at prestigious companies around the world.






At Coda, this comes into play with a building that echoes the dynamism of a dancer's movements. The flowing design of the façade has a modern crafted feel, with full-height windows, painted bronze trims and metal framed balconies. Light streams through the staggered floors, with apartments on the north-east and north-west sides of the building overlooking the river.





Once residents have arrived they are greeted by a friendly concierge, who can help with booking experiences, managing services and local recommendations.



Healthy living is at the heart of the Coda experience. The fitness studio offers sophisticated and modern equipment, including state-of-the-art Peloton bikes.






Private residents' garden


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
