SUSTAINABILITY



First-of-its-kindin-Arizona building utilizing exposed Cross Laminated Timber (CLT) construction



Designed for Silver LEED Certification



Utilization of young trees, a sustainable forestry practice



UFAD system requires less energy from unit to produce heating/cooling



CLT is a renewable material which absorbs and stores carbon by harvesting small diameter timber



The Beam will take the equivalent of 996 cars off the road for a year due to its wood construction



It takes just 15 minutes for U.S. and Canadian forests to grow the amount of wood used in The Beam



2:1 Strength to weight ratio (compared to steel). CLT is 6 times lighter that traditional counterparts without comprising strength



The wood utilized on the project is estimated to capture 4,580 metric tons of carbon dioxide

Thoughtfully-designed tenant amenities feature collaborative and communal spaces





Located in the heart of the Farmers Arts District with more than 165 restaurants within 1 mile
