






HYPOTHETICAL FIRST FLOOR - TECH OFFICE ±42,710 SF








SECOND FLOOR - MARKET READY PLAN SPRING 2024 COMPLETION





HYPOTHETICAL SECOND FLOOR - TECH OFFICE ±42,710 SF









FLOOR PLAN HYPOTHETICAL LAB LAYOUT




