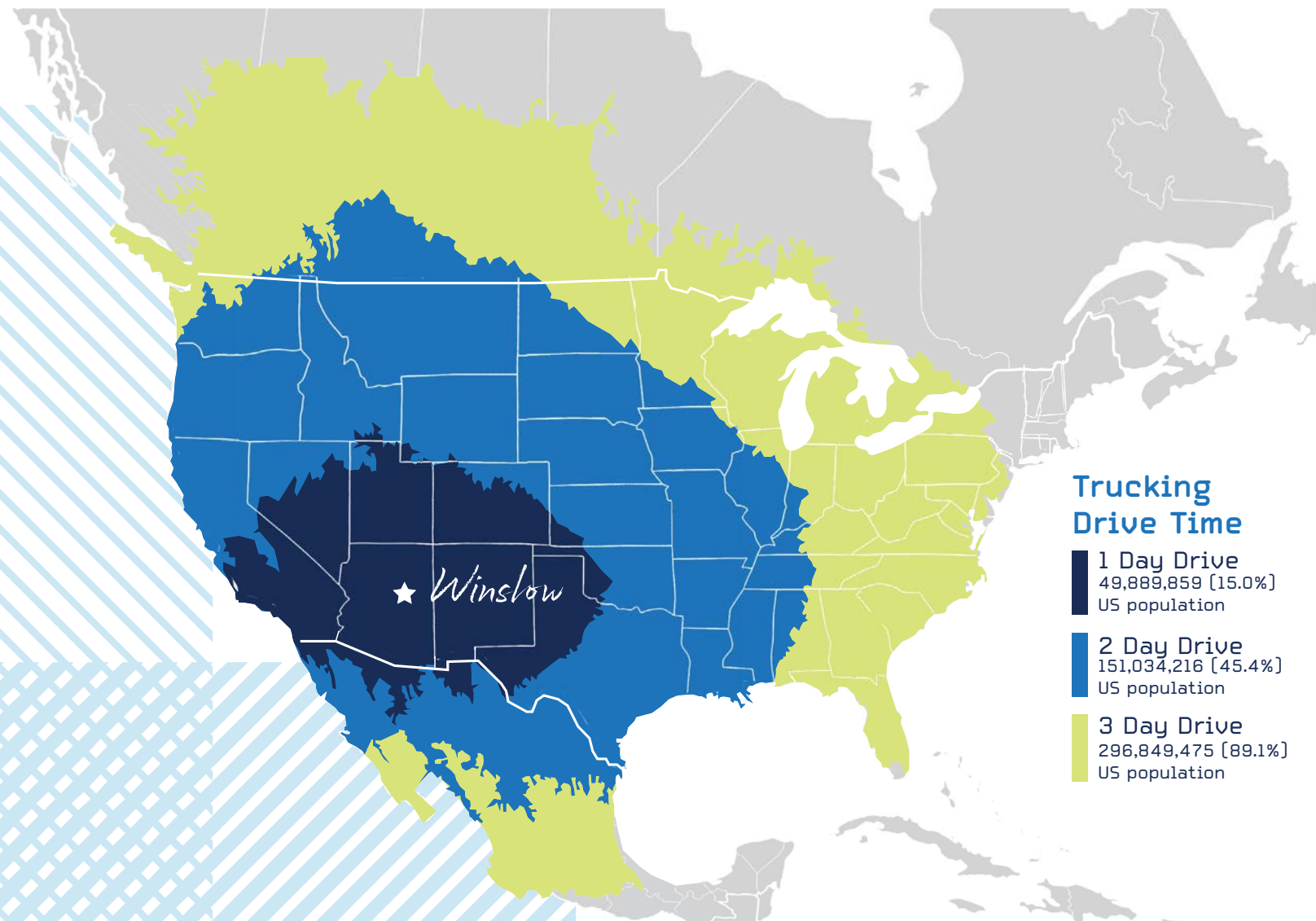

## QUALITY MEDICAL CARE

Not far from Winslow is the Flagstaff Medical Center, a large regional medical center with most of the major medical specialties and the only level one trauma center north of Phoenix. The Little Colorado Medical Center is located directly in Winslow, providing immediate and accessible high-quality healthcare.



## EDUCATION

Education is a priority and valued in Winslow with great public and private school options. Northland Pioneer Community College located in Winslow, and Northern Arizona University just 60 miles away in Flagstaff. Northern Arizona University ranks among the top research universities in the country with over 30,000 students and boasts competitive NCAA sports and strong arts and music programs.



## PARKS AND RECREATION

Winslow is situated centrally to a handful of the country's most interesting and vibrant national parks and monuments. The world-renowned Grand Canyon National Park is just a short two-hour drive away. Take a step back into history at the Petrified Forest within the vast 7,500 square miles of the Painted Desert National Park or visit Meteor Crater.

Outdoor enthusiasts enjoy seemingly endless hiking, mountain, and road biking trails in the Flagstaff area. Skiers from all around Arizona come to the Arizona Snowbowl ski resort, a short 1.5-hour drive from Winslow. Additionally, Northern Arizona provides an abundance of hunting and fishing opportunities.

There are interesting cultural destinations throughout the Navajo and Hopi reservations and in Sedona, Flagstaff, Phoenix, Las Vegas, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Denver, and Los Angeles.
