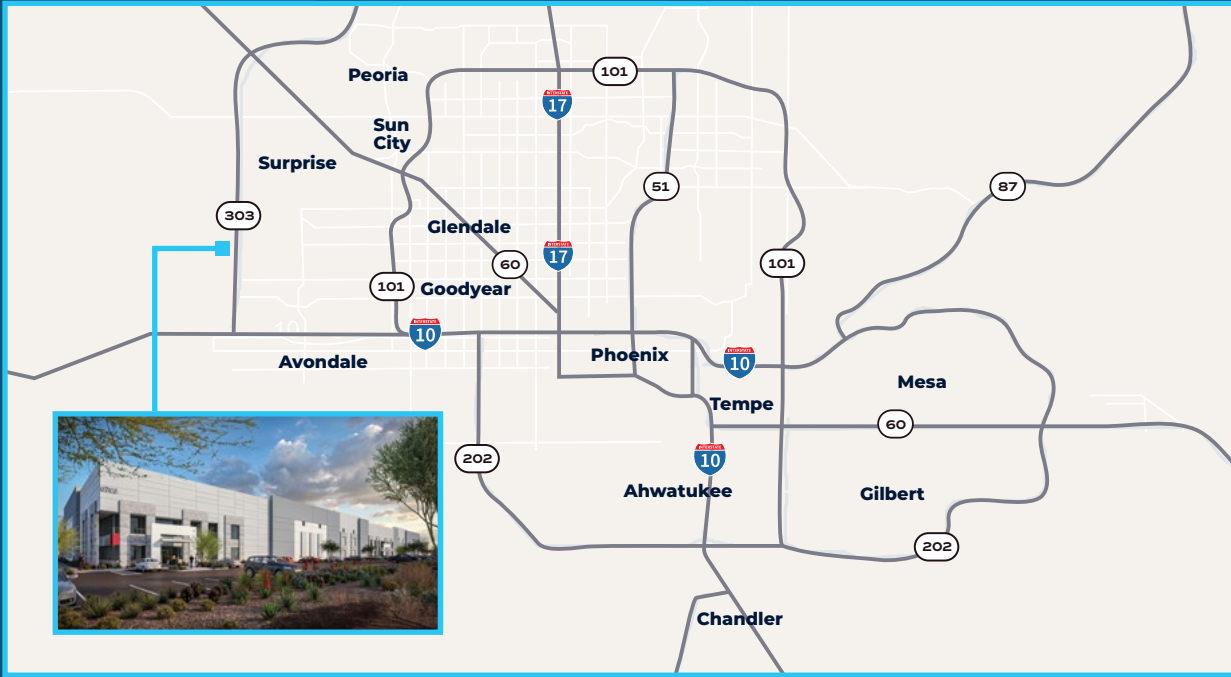

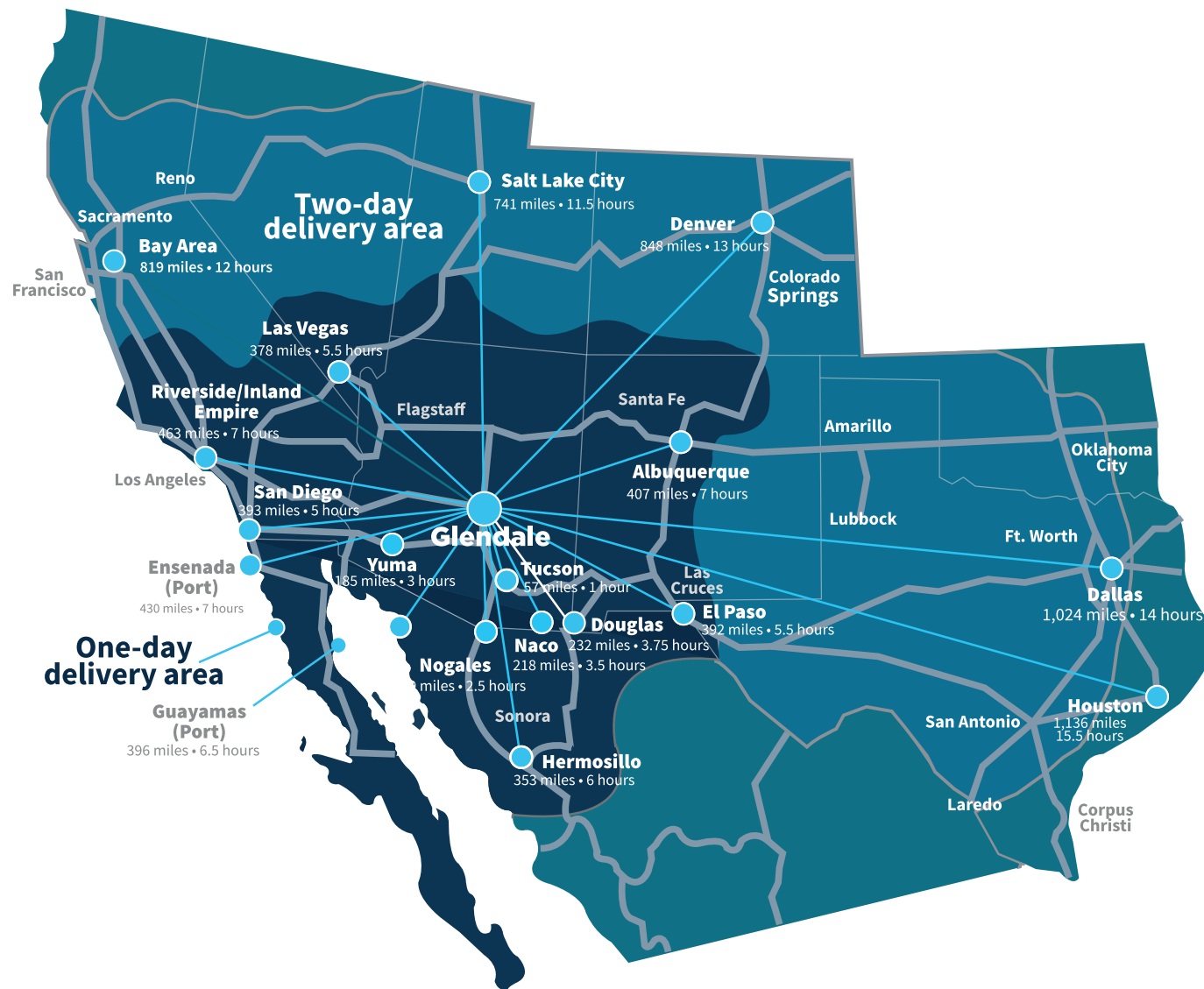

West Valley

The West Valley is home to 1.9 million people — more than a third of Metro Phoenix’s 5.1 million residents — with 65% of that population workforce age.
