### **Updates on Ease of Travel Restrictions to Japan**



#### From June 1st, 2022

- ✓ The on-arrival COVID-19 test and the isolation period after entry into Japan were updated <u>according to the grouping ("Blue", "Yellow" and "Red" categories)</u> of the countries/regions.
- ✓ The daily cap on arrivals increased from 10,000 to 20,000.

#### From June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022

✓ <u>Tourist entry on guided package tours from Countries/Regions in Group</u>

<u>"Blue" will be accepted from 10 June 2022.</u> Regardless of the vaccination status of the entrants, on-arrival test, home isolation and other measures are not required.

#### By the end of June 2022

✓ In addition to the current 5 airports (Haneda, Narita, Kansai, Chubu, Fukuoka),
Naha and New Chitose international airports will resume to accept entrants from abroad in June.

#### A Procedure for Visiting Japan for Tourism Purposes from Countries/Regions in Group "Blue"\*

1 Book a Guided Package Tour

- Apply for a Visa
  - Your travel agency shall obtain the certificate for registration to ERFS\* from the receiving organization in Japan.
  - 2. Apply for a visa at Embassies/Consulates with the ERFS\* certificate received above.

**3** Get a Covid-19 Negative Test Certificate

A Covid-19 test must be conducted within 72 hours prior to your departure. You can find **the format** for the test certificate at the MOFA\* website.

4 Install MySOS app for Quarantine Fast Track

Install **the app**, answer the questionnaire, and register the Covid-19 Negative Test Certificate for smoother quarantine procedures at major airports.

- \* You may select "Will not submit" for status of your vaccination on MySOS.

  Regardless of vaccination status, any form of isolation after entry is not required.


### Requirements for a guided package tour



- 1. Book a guided package tour
- 2. Apply for a visa
- 3. Get a Covid-19 negative test certificate
- 4. Install MySOS app for Quarantine Fast Track
- 5. Go to Visit Japan Web for immigration and customs
- 6. Buy Travel Insurance

#### 2. Apply for a visa



- 1. The receiving organization of the entrants (e.g. land operator) in Japan needs to apply for entry through ERFS\*.
- 2. The travel agency shall obtain **the certificate of registration to ERFS** from the receiving organization in Japan.
- 3. Apply for a visa at Embassies/Consulates with the ERFS certificate received above through the travel agency, or the tourist can apply directly.
- <u>Please check the latest guidance with Embassies/Consulates</u> as there might be specific regulations regarding visa application depending on the country/region.
- Please consult the travel agents or travel service providers (land operator) in Japan, if you have questions about ERFS.

#### Who can be a receiving organization of the entrants for tourism?

Foreign nationals newly entering Japan for a short-term stay for the purpose of tourism will be allowed only when a travel agency organizing the trip serves as the receiving organization of the entrants.

Travel Agencies are such <u>travel agents or travel service providers as defined</u> <u>in the Travel Agency Law of Japan</u>.

### 3. Get a Covid-19 Negative Test Certificate



- All entrants must get a negative test certificate to enter Japan.
- A Covid-19 test must be conducted within 72 hours prior to your departure.
- You can find the format for the test certificate at the MHLW website.

### 4. Install MySOS app for Quarantine Fast Track

- 2. **Answer the questionnaire** on the app.
- 3. Register the Covid-19 Negative Test Certificate on the app.
- \*You may select "Will not submit" for status of your vaccination on MySOS. Regardless of vaccination status, no isolation after entry is required.
- 4. **MySOS screen will turn blue** when all required information is submitted and the authorities' review is complete.
- 5. **Show your MySOS's blue screen** at Quarantine at airports

#### 6. Buy travel insurance



Tourists have to purchase private medical insurance that includes coverage for medical expenses related to Covid-19 and adequate coverage and services.

Please make sure that your customers will be covered by travel insurance during the trip to Japan.

# Guidelines for tourism-related entities in Japan issued by Japan Tourism Agency



#### 1. Who do the new guidelines apply to?

Tourism-related entities in Japan such as

- 1) Travel agents or travel service providers (land operators) as receiving organizations
- 2) **Tour conductors** who accompany tour groups in Japan
- 3) **Accommodations**, etc.

#### 2. Components of the guidelines

These include matters and pointers to be kept in mind by the tourism-related entities in Japan at each stage from the creation of a tour until the end of a tour, such as:

- 1) Rules and policies to be adhered to in order to prevent the spread of the COVID-19
- 2) Emergency response plans in the event that any COVID-19 case arise among tour group
