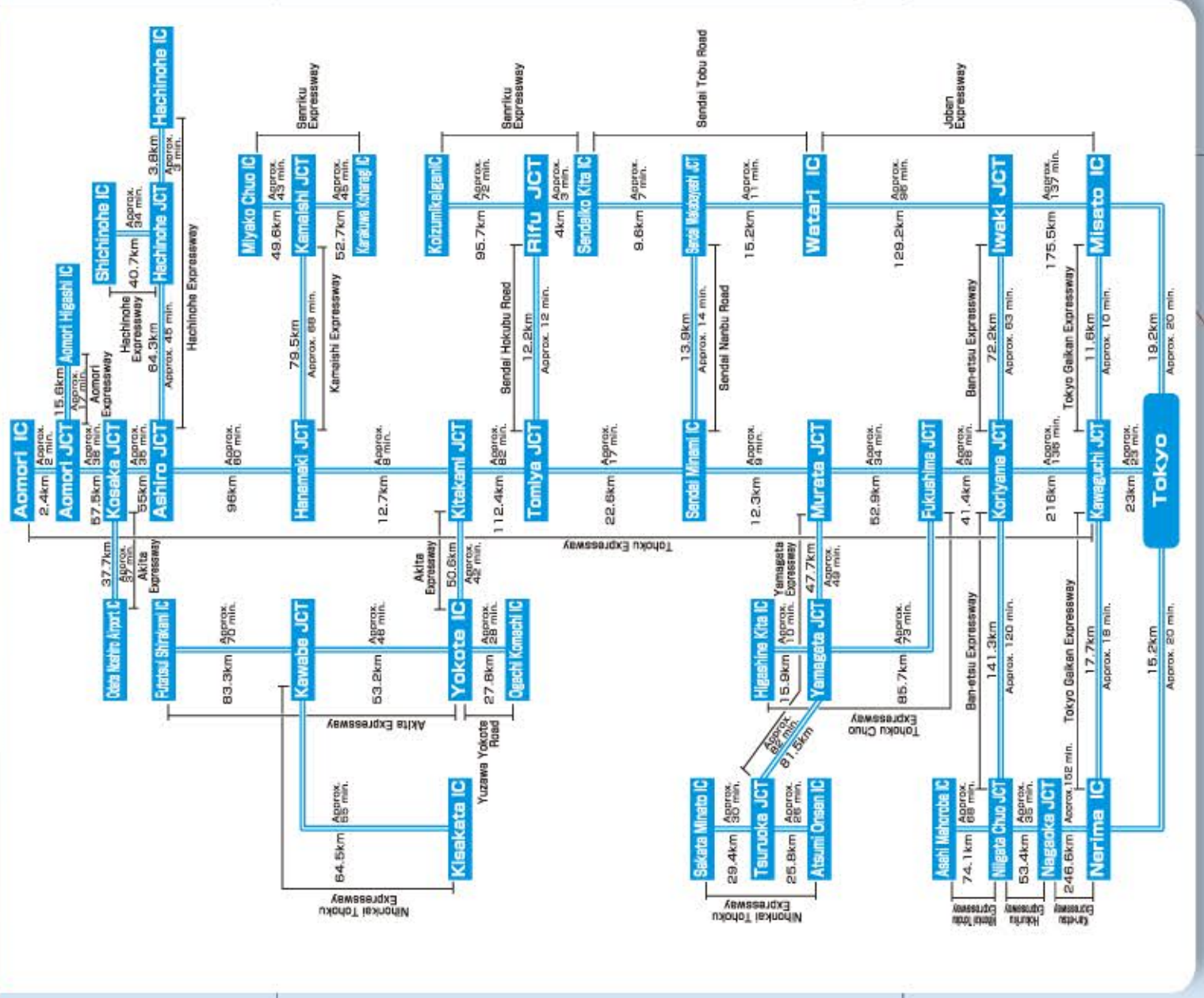


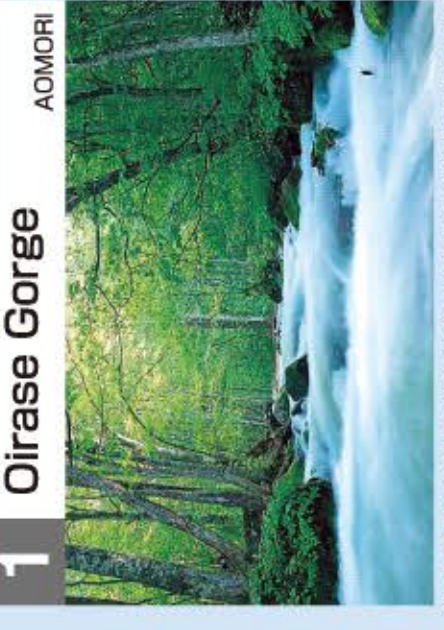

4 Tarai Bune (Tub Boat)

rai bune is a tub-turned boat for Isonegi, inshore fishing, to catch wakame seaweeds, abalones, turban shells, etc. which are operated by Ama, female divers at Ogi Harbor in Sado Bay.



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One of Japan's best scenic spots continuing from Lake Towada. Also called the Waterfalls Road, there are many waterfalls scattered along the mountain stream, and you can enjoy the beauty of nature by driving or walking around at the time of fresh green or autumn leaves.



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Urquidate is called the little Kyoto in Michinoku (Tohoku area). Along the street with a row of samurai fences' black fences, approximately 400 cherry trees adding the 300 years-old weeping cherry tree line up, in bloom, they look vivid against the fences.
