1 Check Your Visa Requirement

Pre COVID-19 visa exemption arrangements are resumed from Oct. 2022. Please refer to [MOFA* website](#) for more details.

2 No Need for a Valid Vaccination Certificate or a COVID-19 Negative Test Certificate

Those who are entering Japan **on or after April 29th 2023** will **not be required** to present a valid vaccination certificate or a COVID-19 negative test certificate.

3 Go to Visit Japan Web for smooth entry

Those who are entering Japan on or after April 29th 2023 **will not be required** to register their quarantine information.

*Medical expenses can be very high for foreign visitors to Japan who get injured or become ill during the stay.
