1. Fukuoka

Explore the birthplace of the rich *Tonkotsu* (pork bone broth) Ramen. Fukuoka boasts around 100 *yatai* stalls offering not just *Tonkotsu* Ramen but also mouth-watering *yakitori* and other local specialties.





2. Kitakyushu

Find yourself entranced by the charming Mojiko Retro district, reminiscent of late 19th-century Japan with cobblestone streets and vintage buildings. This is your chance to savour dishes crafted from fresh local seafood and vegetables while enjoying the stunning views of the Kanmon Straits, known for one of the best nightscapes in Japan.

3. Kumamoto

Kumamoto, one of the leading producers of strawberries in Japan, is a strawberry lover's paradise. Try your hands at strawberry picking experiences and taste the different juicy, luscious varieties that Kumamoto has to offer. Visit the historic Kumamoto Castle and savour the local delicacy, the melt-in-your-mouth *Akaushi* beef.





4. Kagoshima

Indulge in Kagoshima's local favourites, including *Kurobuta* (black pork) *shabu-shabu* and award-winning *Kagoshima Kuroushi* (black beef) Wagyu. While you are there, remember to check out the *Shirokuma kakigori*, a local shaved ice treat that resembles a polar bear!

Kyushu is Japan's southernmost island, comprising 7 prefectures, namely Fukuoka, Saga, Nagasaki, Kumamoto, Oita, Miyazaki, Kagoshima. However, this tour will bring the participants on a deep dive straight into the 4 main, big cities of the region.

Who Can Participate?

Similar to the previous two route applications, this experience is only open to those residing in Singapore and in the participating group it is required to have at least one Singapore Citizen (SC). Participants (and their best friend) must also be agreeable to having their pictures and videos taken by the accompanying JbyJ staff throughout the trip. These photographs and videos will be used for various purposes, such as social media, advertisements, and other materials to help promote Japan as the ideal tourist destination.

Air tickets, accommodation, transportation, and meals included in the finalised itinerary will be provided for. Participants may extend their stay in Japan at their own expense.

Complete the Application: Log in or register as a JAPAN by Japan member and complete the application form for the Kyushu route, including the necessary information and upload your introductory video.

Interview: Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted via email from JbyJ's Campaign Office for an in-person or online interview. Please do remember to check your email, including your junk inbox, for notifications.

What Next?

Upon selection, the winning pair gets to create an itinerary in collaboration with JbyJ staff.

Winners get to then travel to Japan, accompanied by JbyJ staff and professional photographer/videographer to capture your moments!
