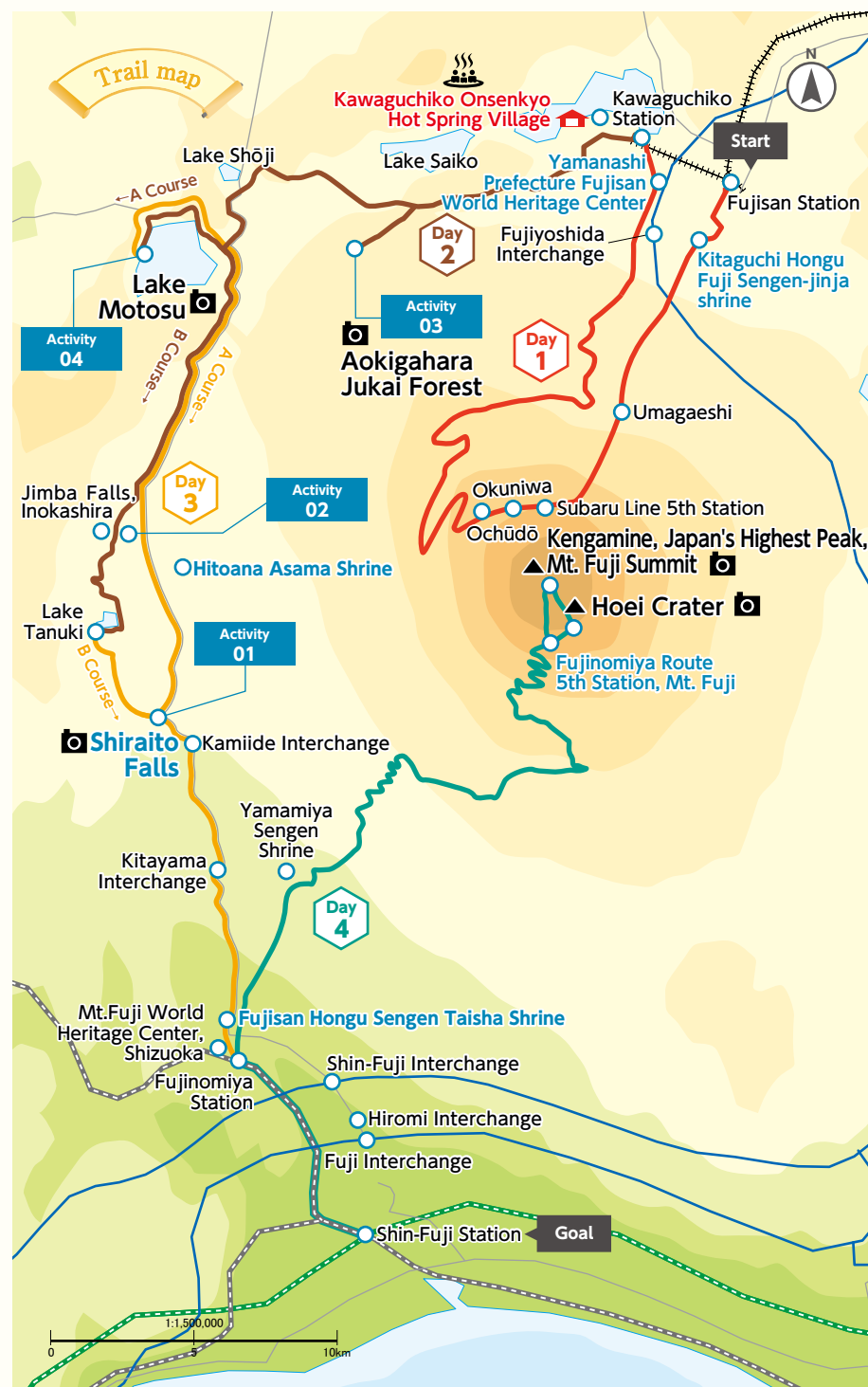

(90min) (The waterfall is a listed part of the world cultural heritage site and was chosen as one of the 100 Waterfalls of Japan. It is famous for being fed by spring water from Mt. Fuji.)
 (Fujikyū Shizuoka Bus) 30min → Fujisan Hongū Sengen Taisha Shrine
(60min) (Visit the satomiya "village" shrine headquarters of the Mt. Fuji Sengen faith and experience the clear waters of Fuji at Wakutama Pond, located within the shrine grounds.)
