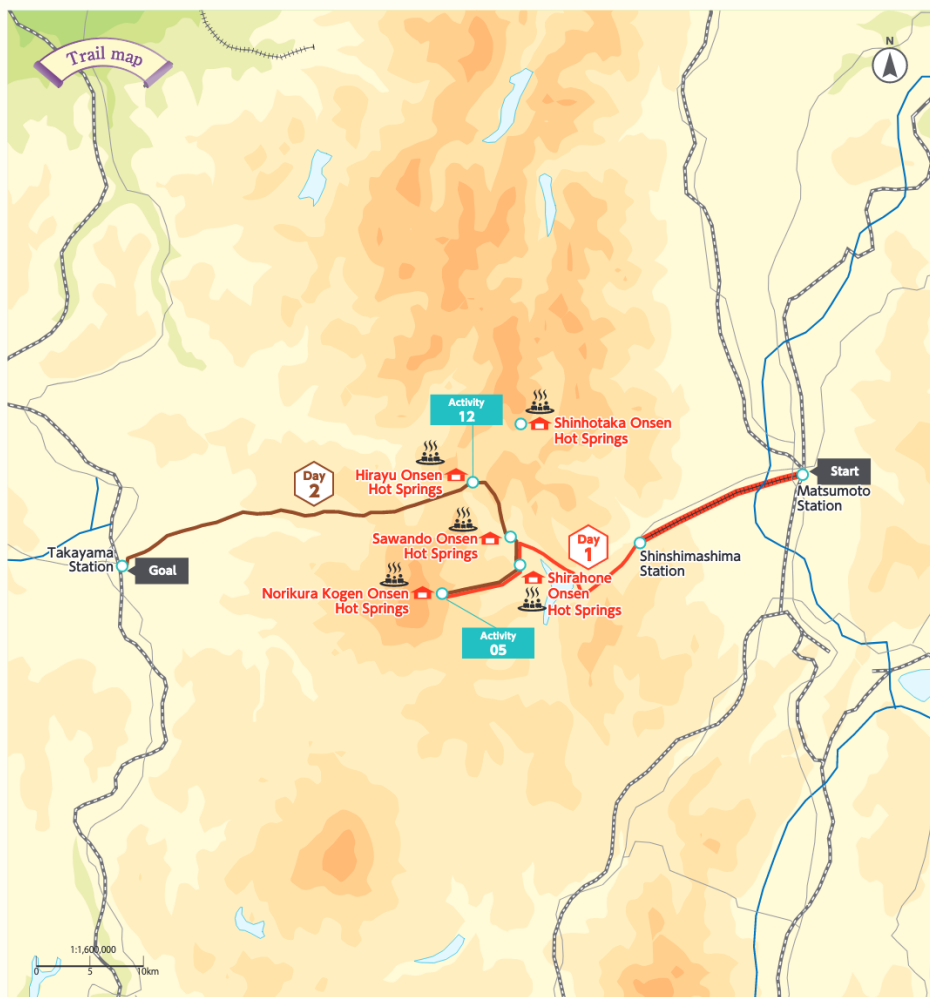

Activity 05 Night Snowshoeing Tour



Zengoro Falls is one of Norikura's Three Waterfalls. This 8m-wide waterfall with a 21.5m plunge transforms into an icicle in winter. The magical sight of this icicle naturally formed by winter temperatures is enough to make anyone feel awe and wonder at its force. When the sky is clear, you can get a magical view of the starry sky and the moon. This is a nighttime adventure tour to a special place you can only access by snowshoe. (rentals available)

2:45p.m. Matsumoto Station (In the morning, it is possible to visit Matsumoto Castle or go shopping along Nakamachi Street and Nawate Street.)

(Train (Alpico Kotsu Kamikochi Line) Approx. 30 min)

3:15p.m. Shinshimashima Station (Alpico Kotsu Bus) Approx. 50min → Norikura Kogen Highlands (A plateau extending over the eastern foothills of Mt. Norikura, Norikura Kogen boasts a variety of hot springs with different water qualities, and bustles with seasonal activities. There are higaeri onsen (day-trip hot spring) facilities for day-trippers, and yukimi ("snow viewing") is possible while bathing. Popular sights here include the large, graceful form of Mt. Norikura, the pastoral landscapes of Ichinose Garden, waterfalls cascading from the tip of the lava plateau, and the rich diversity of flora and fauna, such as wild birds. The area around Mt. Norikura boasts the finest powder snow, brought about by the high altitude and dry climate of Inland Honshu. Admire the frozen Zengoro Falls and Sanbon Falls while in town, and should you arrive early, take advantage of the extra time by trying your hand at various snow activities and snow sports on Mt. Norikura's ski slopes.) → 4:15p.m. Accommodation at Norikura Kogen Highlands →

10:00a.m. Activity 12 Snowshoeing Experience (Approx. 150 min) (Snowshoe through winter's stunning silver scenery with the Snowshoe Experience Tour in Hirayu Onsen Hot Spring. On clear days, travel to the mountaintop by ski lift. Enjoy the popular Kamoshika Slope course, elevation 1700m, and visit the spectacular frozen Hirayu Otaki Falls. After snowshoeing, refresh body and soul in the cloudy waters of the Hirayu no Mori hot springs!) →

12:30p.m. Hirayu (Approx. 180 min) (Lunch and bath at Hirayu-no-Mori) (Nohi Bus) Approx. 60 min →

4:30p.m. Takayama Station (If you arrive early at Takayama Station, it is possible to explore Takayama, or travel towards Kanazawa and Nagoya.)
