Discover the Primeval Forest of the Odaigahara Plateau and the Vast Osugidani Valley

Notes

Enjoy the exquisite valley of Osugidani, a secluded part of the Kinki region where primeval forest and a heavy-rain belt interweave to create a majestic landscape.

Brimming with magical scenery, the Odaigahara Plateau is full of sights to treasure year-round with its alpine plants, fresh verdure and fall colors. Enjoy panoramic views of the Omine Mountain Range from the plateau's precipitous cliffs.







At 135 meters, this waterfall boasts Osugidani Sheer cliffs and the beautiful Nikoniko Falls make Most years see rhododendrons bloom Valley's longest drop.
