WHAT MAKES US DIFFERENT

ItsFunToSew is established to nurture the next generation of fashion designers / artisans for sustainable development. Our key goal is to help our students master tailoring and overcome fears while handling garment production of any type, so our training is very practical in approach.

Registering with us is a way to acquire alternative skills, which one can fall back to even while waiting for bigger job opportunities. This skill can also serve as an additional source of income.

Our Sewing class is categorised into 3 : Basic, Intermediate and Advanced Sewing Classes. They are structured in a way to help participants learn and master the craft. Intending students are advised to take the courses in that order to avoid difficulty in catching up. We however have a foundation course to enable intending participants with prior knowledge to gain understanding before proceeding to Intermediate class. Other specialized courses are General Upgrade on Womenswear, Menswear, Childrenswear and ReadyToWear Production courses. We accept apprenticeships.

Our curriculum is totally a robust complete package beyond fun- you learn Business skills, presentation skills, marketing skills and career development coaching.



CODE OF CONDUCT

1. **ATTENDANCE:** Participants must be punctual. Late coming is solely at the participant's detriment. Except stated otherwise; we train Monday – Thursday (9am to 2pm) and Saturdays /Sundays (1 pm to 3 pm). **STAYING BEYOND THE TRAINING TIME ATTRACTS A FEE.** Participants are to sign attendance registers whenever they come to school for record purposes. Students registering for online classes should be present for all live sessions during the course of their training.
2. **PAYMENT:** Participants are to complete full payment on or before the end of the first month, or will be asked to stop class due to non-completion of school fees. **WE DO NOT REFUND PAYMENTS MADE. Registration slots cannot be transferred from one person to another.**
3. **COURSE DEFERMENT:** Participants are to complete the course registered for within the stated period of training, as **THERE WILL NOT BE** any extension beyond the stated course duration. You can join the next available class at a fee; 70% of the course fee.
4. **MAINTENANCE:** Participants must exercise reasonable care in handling sewing machines and the general facility. Participants must ensure absolute respect for the environment, no littering and absolute care when using the restroom. Kindly leave it tidy for the next user. Do not urinate on the floor. Phones must be on silent during class to avoid distraction.
5. **STUDENTS TAILORING KIT:** Participants are to come to class with their tailoring kit and leave with them after class as VEDIL CLOTHING is not to be held accountable for any loss or misplaced 'property'.
6. **CERTIFICATE:** Participants are to pay 20,000 naira for the certificate. However, Participants who did not complete all assignments and tasks will not be given certificates. Participants are to showcase their final project at the end of the year party / Award of certificate day. Any participant not showcasing will not be given a certificate.
7. **INTERNSHIP:** Participants who registered and did well (by completing all tasks and assignments) in Basic and Intermediate classes are given opportunity to intern with Vedil Garment Factory for a month before proceeding to the Advanced sewing class
8. **APPRENTICESHIP:** We accept intakes for apprenticeship for those that meet the requirement. Check the page for apprenticeship for further details.
9. **ASSESSMENT BOOKLET:** This will be required from any student at the point of certificate application.

BECOME AN APPRENTICE WITH VEDIL CLOTHING

Congratulations on the award of APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMME.

APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMME at VEDIL CLOTHING is specially designed for those who want to have a more practical approach to learning Fashion Designing; using the learning on the job approach.

Stated below are the terms and conditions of this programme:

1. WORK DAYS: You are required to abide by the agreed Opening and Closing hours 8am to 6pm. Monday to Friday are our working days.
2. You are to participate in the general cleaning and maintenance of the work environment. Ensuring that equipment and tools are kept in good condition after use.
3. DURATION: Apprenticeship programme runs for a period of 1 year.
4. VEDIL CLOTHING has the right to terminate this agreement if you fail to comply by the rules guiding working at Vedil clothing. Read through the Code of Conduct for work at VEDIL CLOTHING, Given to you by the manager.
5. FEES: 400,000 naira, a carton of Malt and carton of biscuit are required for apprenticeship. Upon SATISFACTORY completion, the trainee makes a payment of 20,000 for certificate.
