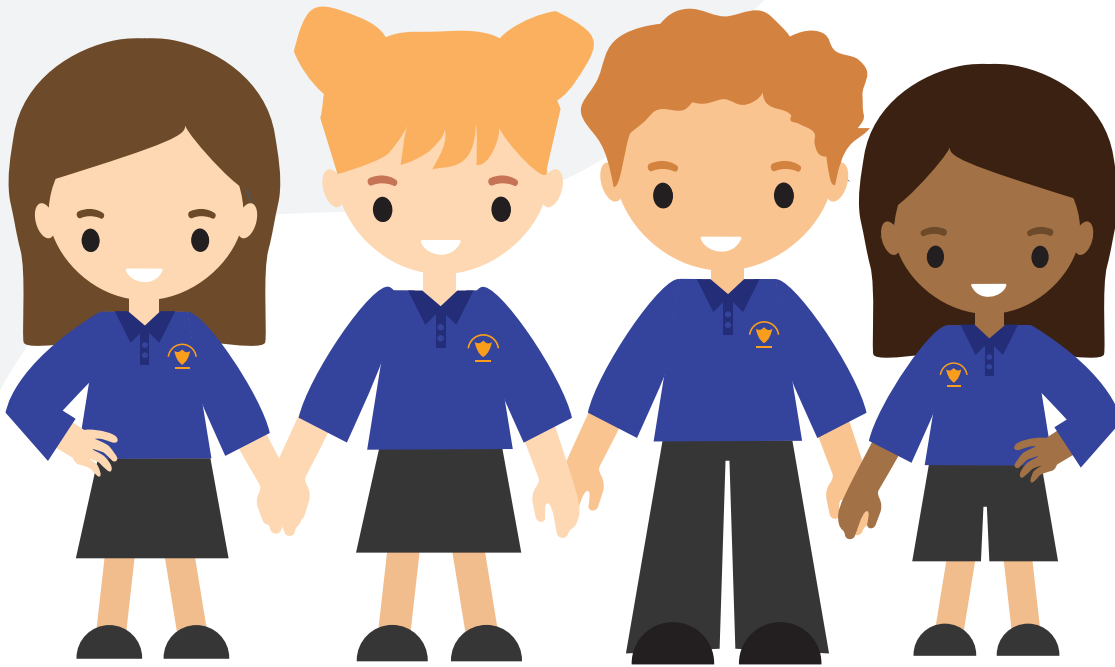

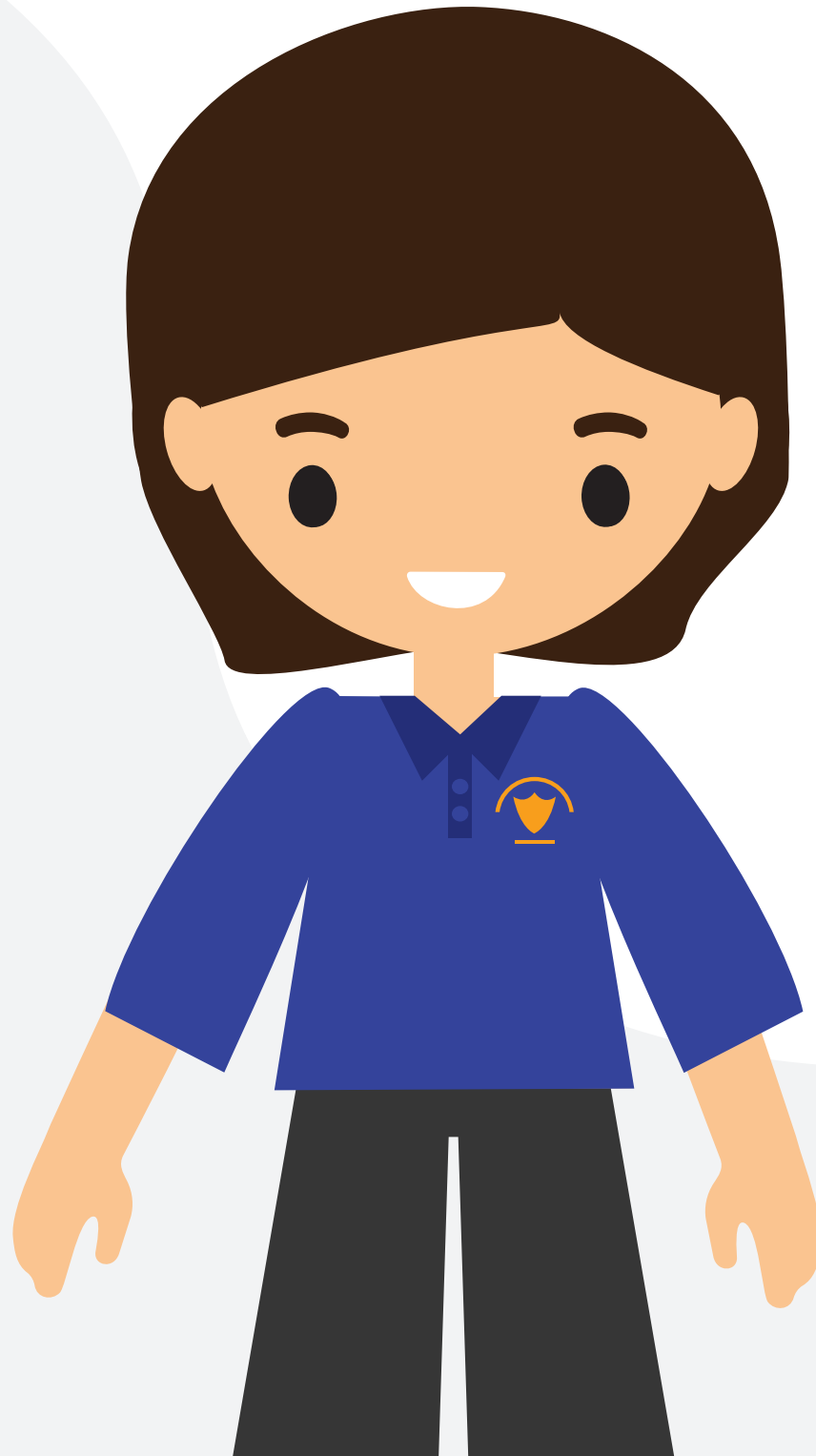

with you?



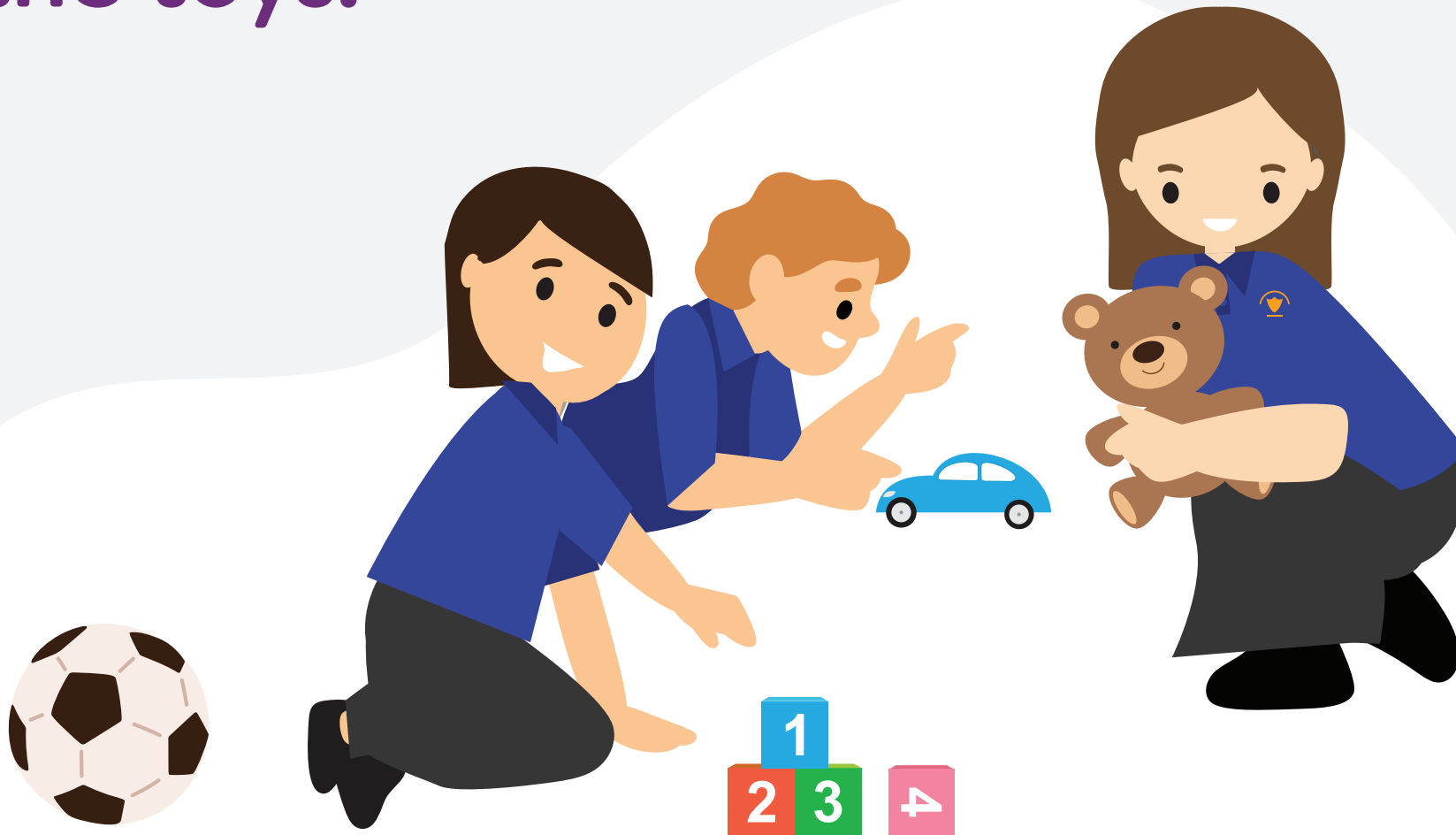
If they say, **Yes!** we can share toys

If I am feeling nervous about playing with a friend, there are things I can do to help myself feel better.

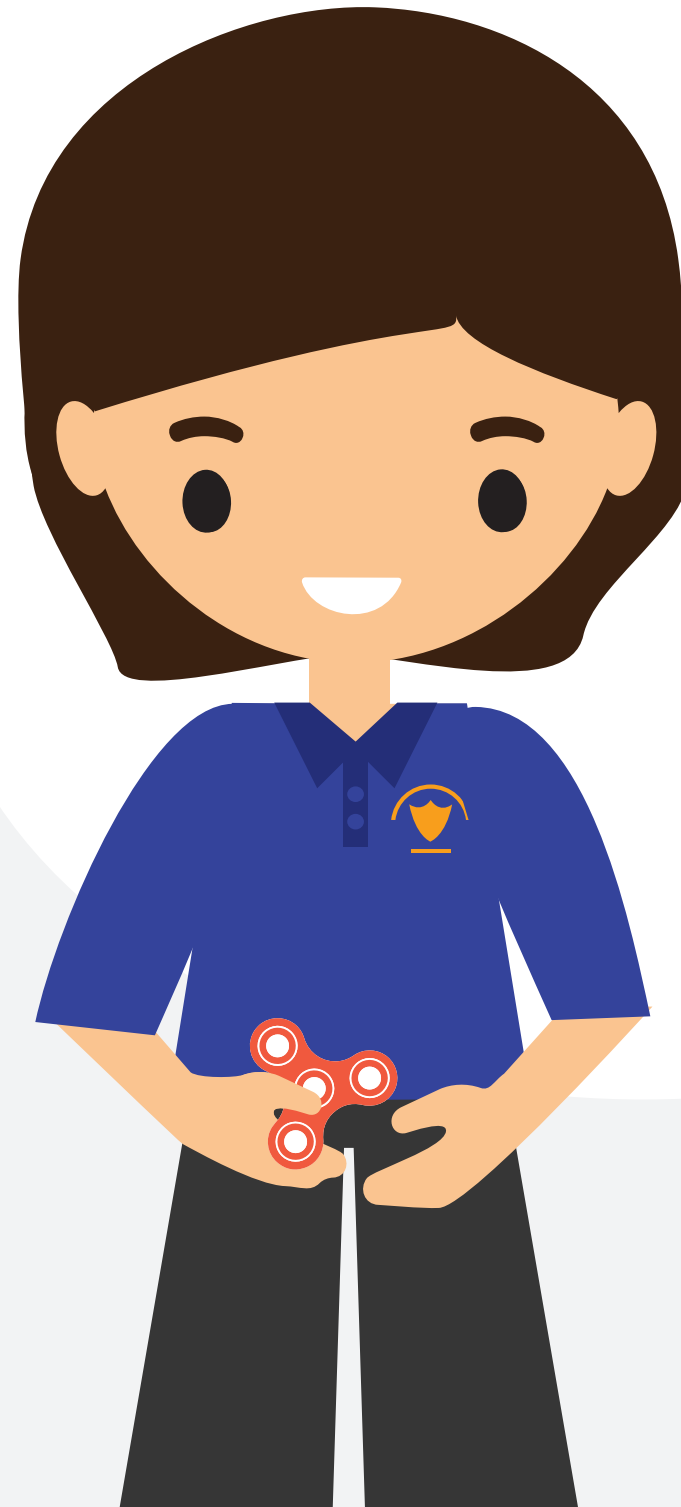


I can talk to
