Objective of the proposed innovation project– this MUST involve activity that results in the development of or introduction to the market of a new product or service (max 300 words)	To pilot a range of culturally competent therapeutic services for young people at high risk of involvement in violence, their families and the professionals working with them, resulting in a replicable, evidenced model which can be scaled up nationally, with the ultimate objective of empowering individuals and communities to end violence affecting young people.
Company's current situation – existing project team and innovation project development stage (max 400 words)	Power The Fight recently launched a research report called <u>Therapeutic Intervention for Peace (TIP)</u> , focused on developing culturally competent therapeutic services for families and peers affected by traumatic loss through youth violence. The research was supported by the Mayor of London's Violence Reduction Unit in recognition of the lack of appropriate provision currently offered in the aftermath of incidents, and the impact of this gap on individuals and communities from racial minority backgrounds.
	Power The Fight has begun a 6-month pilot of TIP in a secondary school in South London and has been offered provisional funding to expand this pilot to at least two other schools over 12 months, in addition to increasing the reach of the project in the initial school.
	TIP is led by Power The Fight's CEO and Clinical Lead, supported by a Therapeutic Youth Practitioner and Project Manager. If funding is secured, the team will expand to include two Clinical Psychologists, two qualified Counsellors and an additional Therapeutic Youth Practitioner.

(max 400 words)	Power The Fight requires expertise in research monitoring and evaluation, ensuring that learning and appropriate evidence are captured throughout the pilot, leading to a fully evidenced and replicable model which has been robustly evaluated. We require this expertise from a consultant with a background in Criminology, focused on violence affecting young people, with specific expertise in factors affecting racial disproportionality within the criminal justice system.
