	The Platform will also build upon today's foundational elements (tools that help with developer experience) to be more than just code.



	The technical core will be a set of packages, scripts, and processes, which empower us to deliver high- quality websites that give clients a measurable return on their investment.
Company's current situation – existing project team and innovation project development stage (max 400 words)	About Indigo Tree:
	Trading since 2011, Indigo Tree have over 200 clients. We work across multiple sectors from non-profit and schools to commercial retailers.
	We have an office in Tring, Hertfordshire but our employees are a mix of office-based and remote across the UK. We have 13 employees and are female-led and owned.
	Indigo Tree is well-known in the UK Agency and WordPress community and (pre-pandemic) have attended, sponsored, and spoken at WordCamp Conferences and monthly WordPress Meetups.
	Our team, of developers is led by our Engineering Director and this is an opportunity for an <b>enthusiastic developer</b> to work on this project alongside other experienced team members to deliver this new software Platform.
	We will be planning the product development using our internal team. Before we start this, we would like some assistance and advice from our knowledge base partner on <b>market research</b> and <b>product</b> <b>development</b> that we can undertake to understand client needs and translate these into product features.
	Current status of the project:
	1/ The development work started in April 2021 with the technical setup of the tooling (software) that will be required to develop the platform.
	2/ We have not yet started on the platform and market research and product development.
	<b>Project Team:</b> The existing project team is three Indigo Tree employees, the MD, Engineering Director and Technical Lead Developer.
	Our Managing Director will be planning the platform product development once the market research has been undertaken.



	Our Engineering Director is responsible for our technical roadmap, managing the project, scope of work and translating our roadmap into a project plan and deliverables. Our Senior Developer is the Technical Lead contracted to work on this project 20% of their time (5 days per month).

(max 400 words)	1/ We are seeking a <b>software developer</b> with experience in building front-end solutions using React and API development. The developer would work in a team alongside our Technical Lead, and Engineering Director, to deliver the Platform software.
	While the developer is expected to work up to 5 days a week on this project, Indigo Tree is an inclusive employer and some of our team work flexibly, so 4 days would also be an option for the right candidate.

KEEP+ provides maximum allowable grants for its specific types of intervention. Those intervention types and maximum grant levels are as follows;

- KEEP Knowledge Exchange Embed Partnership (typically 12 months' duration) this intervention involves a graduate working on a mid- to long-term activity with the support of a specific academic staff member, the graduate is based within the beneficiary company grant allowance 50% of eligible costs and £10,000 capital.
- KEEP Research and Innovation Collaboration (no fixed duration) this intervention involves an academic colleague working on a short- to long-term activity, they are based at the Knowledge Base but with regular face-to-face interaction with the beneficiary company grant allowance 50% of eligible costs plus a strict maximum of £10,000 capital.

The following is a guide to the types of cost that you should expect to occur should your application be successful;



- KEEP Knowledge Exchange Embed Partnership (typically 12 months' duration) project development, associate wage, academic wage, administrative support, training and travel (on the part of the knowledge base employees), minor equipment (please note there is a potential separate grant for major capital purchases), recruitment
