Objective of the proposed innovation project— this MUST involve activity that results in the development of or introduction to the market of a new product or service (max 300 words)	Blackmore Four is a high-impact performance consultancy who supports business leaders in achieving outstanding levels of business performance, by ensuring that their organisation is working at its most effective to achieve overarching strategic goals.	
	The objective of our proposed project is to introduce a novel solution (service) to our current and prospective clients.	
	Currently we offer a Leadership Assessment solution based on a model and product that already exists. The assessment is delivered as a contact session, with data being recorded by candidates using a pen and paper format.	
	Blackmore Four have now created a completely new Leadership and Management model, based on our own research and development. We would like to digitise this solution, so the assessment would be completed, and data captured through a web application.	
Company's current situation – existing project team and innovation project development stage (max 400 words)	Marzenna Almendro (Client Solutions Manager) has conducted the research and compilation of the initial, novel Leadership and Management model.	
	Matthew Emerson (Managing Director) has provided his own insights and peer review in devising the L&M model.	
	To date, there does not appear to be a model for Leadership and Management competencies as extensive as the one devised by the abovementioned team.	



	The solution is ready for digitisation as an assessment to be completed by the participant on a laptop or desktop (not IOS/Android).
	The team have leveraged against their experience and expertise in developing this model, with Marzenna (project lead) possessing a post-graduate degree in Psychology, having specialised in psychometrics/quantitative psychology, and Matthew (MSc Business Psychology) offering his insights seated in 20 years in talent management.
	Both Marzenna and Matthew are members of the BPS (British Psychology Society).

Business need – what expertise and support is required to reach the objective(s) above? (max 400 words)	The web application we wish to create requires a level of expertise within the Computer Sciences field.
	The dynamic front end and back end of the solution requires the application of a specialist/team of specialists competent in developing software technology, skills in programming languages (mastery in HTML, CSS and JavaScript frameworks) and databases (such as SQL). They would have a demonstrated portfolio proving their understanding of the user interface, so that the solution translates into a viable process for the participant.
	Not critical, yet desirable, would be experience in the realm of assessments and potentially psychological constructs.
