## Suggested Itinerary: Half-Day Visit

Family with Children Over 10 Years of Age

### Option 1: With the Kennedy Space Center Bus Tour\*

DURATION: About 5.5 hours (not including wait times)

- Kennedy Space Center Bus Tour (3 hours including travel)
  - The Gantry at LC-39 (60 minutes)
  - Apollo/Saturn V Center (60 minutes)
- Gateway: The Deep Space Launch Complex® (30 minutes)
- Space Shuttle Atlantis® (60 minutes)
- Dining and shopping (60 minutes)

#### **Option 2: Without the Kennedy Space Center Bus Tour**

DURATION: About 5 hours (not including wait times)

- Gateway: The Deep Space Launch Complex<sup>®</sup> featuring Spaceport KSC (minimum height: 44 inches / 112 cm) (60 minutes)
- Space Shuttle Atlantis<sup>®</sup> with the Shuttle Launch Experience (minimum height: 44 inches / 112 cm) (60 minutes)
- Heroes & Legends featuring the U.S. Astronaut Hall of Fame® (30 minutes)
- Astronaut of the Day autograph session (15 minutes)
- It's a Matter of Fact (30 minutes)
- Rocket Garden (15 minutes)
- Journey To Mars (15 minutes without show)
- Dining and shopping (60 minutes)

#### Additional Tips and Reminders:

- Wait times vary based on seasonal attendance.
- This list of attractions is in no particular order, offering flexibility to your day.
- Pick up a Daily Schedule upon arrival or download the *Kennedy Space Center Official Guide* on Google Play or the App Store for show times, exhibit operating hours, special appearances, etc.
- Plan to arrive 15 minutes early for all shows.
- \*For half-day visits, check the daily schedule upon arrival for Bus Tour hours, as it closes earlier than other attractions. We highly recommend taking the Bus Tour upon your arrival to minimize wait times if you have at least four (4) hours.
