

## Suggested Itinerary: Two-Day Visit

Family with Children Over 10 Years of Age

### Day One

DURATION: About 6 hours (not including wait times)

- Gateway: The Deep Space Launch Complex® featuring Spaceport KSC (60 minutes)
  - New Shepard Flight to Space VR Simulator (15 minutes) - Reservations required
- Space Shuttle Atlantis® with the Shuttle Launch Experience (75 minutes)  
(minimum height: 44 inches / 112 cm)
- Chat with an Astronaut **Add-on enhancement** (60 minutes)
  - Alternative: Astronaut Encounter (40 minutes)
  - Alternative: Astronaut of the Day autograph session (15 minutes)
- Rocket Garden (15 minutes)
- Character Appearance (15 minutes)
- It's a Matter of Fact (30 minutes)
- Dining and shopping (60 minutes)

### Day Two

DURATION: About 6.5-7 hours (not including wait times)

- Kennedy Space Center Bus Tour (3 hours including travel)
  - The Gantry at LC-39 (60 minutes)
  - Apollo/Saturn V Center (60 minutes)
- Heroes & Legends featuring the U.S. Astronaut Hall of Fame® (130 minutes)
- Journey To Mars (15 minutes without show)
- IMAX space film (60 minutes)
- Hyperdeck VR (20 minutes) - Reservations required
- Dining and shopping (60 minutes)

- This list of attractions is in no particular order, offering flexibility to your day.
- Note height restrictions for rides. Excluding rides will give an extra 45-60 minutes in your day.
