 - Alternative: Astronaut of the Day autograph session (15 minutes)
- IMAX space film (60 minutes)
- Dining and shopping (60 minutes)

Day Two

DURATION: About 7 hours (not including wait times)

- Kennedy Space Center Bus Tour (3 hours including travel)
 - The Gantry at LC-39 (60 minutes)
 - Apollo/Saturn V Center (60 minutes)

- Mission Status Briefing (20 minutes)
