



INFORMATION ON THE USE AND PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 (REGULATION EU/2016/679) “GDPR”

according to article 13 contained in Regulation EU/2016/679 and in view of Italian D.Lgs. 101/2018, the Data Controller - “*Università di Torino*”, provides to the interested party, in compliance with the principle of transparency, the following information with the aim to make you aware about characteristics and processing methods on your personal data.

a) Data Controller identification and contact details:

The Data Controller is the “*Università di Torino*” via G. Verdi, 8 – 10124 Torino whose pro tempore legal representative is the Chancellor (contact details: pec: ateneo@pec.unito.it - email: rettore@unito.it).

b) The Data Protection Officer (DPO) contact details:

c) Purpose of the processing and legal basis

The University of Turin is a public institution of higher education and research (Article 1 of the Statute of the University of Turin, and art. 33 of the Italian Constitution).

The personal data will be used by the University for the purpose of realising the Internationalisation of I/II level teaching and informing GDPR complaints about University programs and initiatives.

The legal basis for the pursuit of the purposes mentioned above will be performed, pursuant to GDPR article 6, paragraph 1, letter e): “*processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller*”.

d) Types of data processed

The Data Controller processes these personal data:

- Identifying information (first name, last name)
- Contact information (email address, telephone number)
- Information on desired educational path
- Language preferences and country of residence
- Technical information (IP address, device type, browser)



e) Processing methods

The processing of personal data will take place using manual, IT and telematic tools, and will guarantee the security and confidentiality of the data.

To achieve the aforementioned aims, the data is processed by authorized subjects (those in charge of technical support for the platform, researchers, etc.), who are in turn required to respect confidentiality and to comply with the formalities required for data processing.

f) Categories of recipients of personal data and Data Processors

The personal data will be communicated and processed externally by third party technical experts / technical services suppliers, who act on behalf of the Data Controller for the exclusive purpose of the requested service and who are appointed as "Data Processors" according to article 28 of EU Regulation 2016/679.

The personal data will be disclosed to the following recipients and Data Processor:

Furthermore, the data will not be processed for commercial or marketing purposes or transferred to third parties.

g) Data transfer to third country

The Data Controller uses Google's Educational services with appropriate warranty measures in place (see Google's Privacy and Security section for further details in the University website privacy section).

These services may involve the transfer of personal data to non - EEA countries including Google's LLC "Cloud" solutions). Google has joined the EU–US Data Privacy Framework adopted on 10 July 2023 by the EU Commission.

h) Data retention period

The personal data is only kept for the necessary processing time (according to needs and purpose of the processing).



Personal contact data (name, surname and email address) will be kept until the realisation of the above mentioned purposes (lett. c.).

i) Rights over data

The interested party can freely exercise their rights with regard to the personal data processed by the Data Controller under articles from 15 to 21 of EU Regulation 2016/679 by sending a specific request concerning: "Privacy rights" to the International Relations Office at the following email address: internationalpartnerships@unito.it.

j) Complaint

The interested party has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority and can contact the Italian Authority for the protection of personal data at: www.gpdp.it.

k) Automated processes including Profiling
