Plug sockets in cable trays

Up to now, plug sockets (Type NETBOX MK) designed for integration in desktop cable trays have been supplied with an adhesive strip so that they could be positioned flexibly anywhere in the cable tray.

Change:

The supplier has changed the design of the plug sockets so that attaching them with an adhesive strip is no longer recommended due to safety requirements. In future cable trays will be supplied with the plug sockets placed inside, but no longer attached. In this context, please note that in order to comply with correct use, the action of removing a three-pin plug from a socket always necessitates holding the socket housing at the same time. This applies to individual sockets as well as interconnected ones.

Sockets that have been in stock for a while and still have the adhesive strip will be supplied with a note advising the customer to place the sockets in the cable tray.

Once existing stocks have run out, sockets will no longer be supplied with the adhesive strip in future.



GS conformity is met in full if the sockets are placed in the cable tray.
