

The supplier will convert the guide rails to a new, optimised product with better running properties. In this context, the filling frame will also be adapted on the design side.

Specification

Matrix guide, anti-friction bearing guide with differential over-extension and self-closing and damping on both sides, load capacity 50 kg.



Change

The change applies to the following series:

- ACTA.CLASSIC and ACTA.PLUS: filling frames behind hinged doors, sliding doors, tambour doors, filing cabinets with vertical extensions, combi-cupboards with vertical extensions
- ACTA.MODUL: modules with vertical extension and double drawer
- **ECO.S Mobil** with filling frames
- The exact width dimension changes for all **cabinets with a system width of 450 mm.** The previous width of 448 mm (ACTA.CLASSIC) and 444 mm (ACTA.PLUS and ACTA.PLUS wardrobe) is changed to 450 mm, independently of the use of filling frames. Due to the new width dimension, the clear inside dimension also changes the affected individual and furnishing parts, such as plinths, shelves, pigeon-hole set, etc.)

The change affects the installation of filling frames and safety interlocks. Please note that old and new filling frames and safety interlocks are <u>not compatible</u>.

New article numbers and options are provided for the new versions. The prices remain unchanged.
