Product benefits

As part of the continuous improvement process, we aim to offer user-oriented solutions that reflect the latest developments in technology.

ACTA.PLUS locker cabinets and wardrobes (**S8**) have been structurally and functionally revised and are being replaced by ACTA.LOCKER (**SX**). The recent enhancements have given ACTA.LOCKER added value in design, functionality, and usability, and the additional configuration options make it ideal for an even wider range of applications.

ACTA.LOCKER is competitively priced to meet market expectations.

New features and changes

- + Design: The revised design offers a choice of two configurations. Top and bottom panels are either positioned between the side walls or rest on top of them.
- + Finish colours: They are no longer restricted to the carcass colour and can now be selected individually for side panels, back panels, as well as top and bottom elements. The edge colour can also be selected individually.
- + System widths: They correspond to the structural widths. This means the manufactured width is no longer reduced by 2 mm.
- + New widths: As well as widths 400 mm and 800 mm, the new widths 500, 600, 1000 and 1200 mm have been added.
- + Front with letter tray recess: Access to personal storage can now also be provided via a new integrated letter tray in the door.
- + Drawers: Expand the options for making more effective use of storage space in the lower access area if conventional shelf configurations with doors or open fronts are not suitable. A closed panel is no longer offered.

- + Keypad lock: The range of locking options now includes the TA03 PRO / M410 electronic keypad lock, ensuring compatibility with all commonly used systems.
- + Lock placement: The height of the lock placement on the front is customisable depending on user requirements.
- + Handle positions for wardrobe: Horizontally or vertically placed handles can contribute to both aesthetic appeal and user experience.
- + Plinth and base variants: Round or square glides expand the options in terms of positioning.
- + Decorative back panels in veneer: For freestanding placement in the room, veneered back panels offer an elegant alternative. Enclosures for cabinet systems with side panels provide a cohesive design framework.
- + Pre-drilled holes for wardrobes: Continuous or in 5-hole increments.

ACTA.PLUS and ACTA.LOCKER units are fully compatible.
