Product optimisation and changes:

In future all FREECODE locks will be supplied as a redesigned version with optimised functionality and ease of use.

The new “dial lock public” lock from Lehmann combines intuitive operation and clear signalling. The operating concept has been fundamentally revised in order to meet the needs of frequently changing users even more effectively. Programming a code and locking takes just three steps. Setting the code requires deliberate actions, which eliminates operator error from the outset – for instance accidentally resetting the combination. Locks are available as left or right versions, which always lock in the direction of the striking plate.

1. Installation position:

FIXCODE and FREECODE combination locks are no longer designed to be installed upright, they are now fitted horizontally.

2. New operating concept for FREECODE:

A reference line and clearly defined stop positions help to rotate the correct numbers to the front. The programming switch ensures that the selected code is stored. The code can then be scrambled by turning the knob through 90 °. A clear signal language displays the lock status. The position marking on the turn knob is at right-angles to the reference line for the dials when open, and a green indicator can be seen on both sides. If the red indicator is visible (from any angle), it is locked and the position marking forms a line with the reference line for the dials.

3. Availability and options:

The current vertically fitted locks will still temporarily be available as an option in the OFML data until the end of 2024 and can be selected for use with existing locker systems. This ensures a uniform look once installed.

4. Product codes and prices:

The new locks can be ordered using option codes FIXCODE ZFIXH and FREECODE ZPUBH. Prices remain unchanged.

5. Availability and after-sales:

Because of the different lock fitting position, the change will always mean new fronts. New locks cannot be used for old doors.

The new FREECODE lock measurements are different from the FIXCODE lock. This means that when a FREECODE lock is retrospectively replaced with a FIXCODE or vice versa, a new front will also be needed.

Availability of individual old-style locks for after-sales service is temporarily assured. They can be selected in the pCon data from Week 31.
