# LB Medium (Lennox), Powder

## **Product description:**

#### General

LB Medium after the recipe of Lennox is a standard medium for growth and propagation of *E. coli*. The salt content is suitable for plasmid production, but enables as well the addition of magnesium chloride by phage amplifications. Ideal for cultures, which need salt-sensitive antibiotica e.g. Zeocin.

Composition	Component	Concentration
	Tryptone	10 g/l
	Yeast extract	5 g/l
	NaCl	5 g/l

### Storage

Recommended storage temperature of powder is  $+15 \text{ }^{\circ}\text{C} - +30 \text{ }^{\circ}\text{C}$ . Keep container tightly closed, because powder is very hygroscopic.

# Solution procedure:

To prepare 1 I medium:

- 1. Fill 900 ml water dest. in an 1-liter flask. Suspend 20 g powder medium while stirring.
- 2. Adjust to pH 7 with ca. 0.2 ml 5 N NaOH with stirring, fill up to a final volume of 1 liter.
- 3. Then autoclave medium for 20 min. at 121 ℃.
