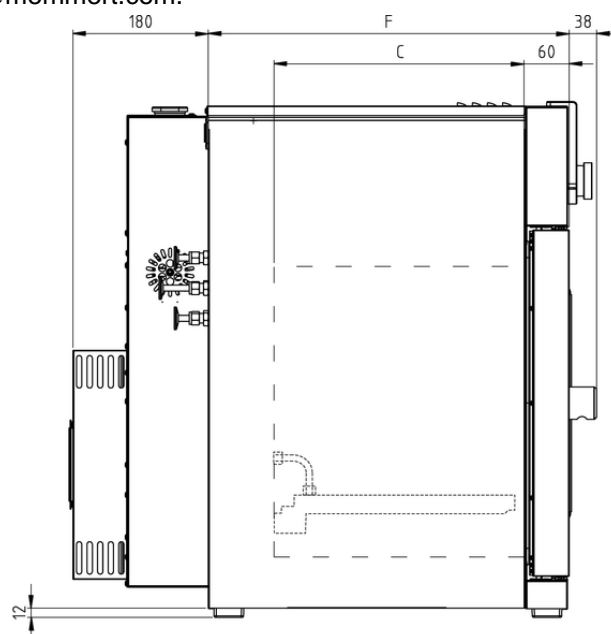
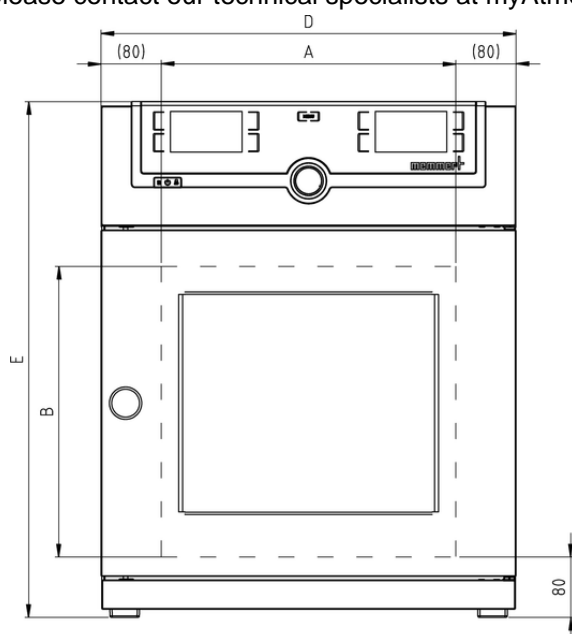

## Temperature

<b>Working temperature range</b>	from 5°C (at least 20 below ambient temperature) to +90°C
<b>Setting temperature range</b>	from +5°C up to +90°C

## Pressure (Vacuum)

<b>Vacuum range</b>	5 to 1100 mbar
<b>Pressure control</b>	Digital electronic pressure control for a speed-controlled vacuum pump. Tubing for vacuum, air and inert gas are made of material 1.4571 (ASTM 316 Ti). Programmable, digitally controlled inlet for air.
<b>Permitted final vacuum</b>	0.01 mbar

<b>Pump control</b>	speed control, optimised rinsing procedures for the pump membranes as well as signal output for pump ON/OFF

## Heating concept

<b>Thermoshelves</b>	1 connection for thermoshelves in the rear

<b>VO direct heating</b>	fuzzy-supported MLC (Multi-Level-Controlling) microprocessor controller adapting its performance to the volume (local temperature sensing)
