PROGRAMME

Day 1: Arrival in Quillan

Arrival at Quillan hotel. Free evening to visit the city. Night in Quillan.

Day 2: From Quillan to Mirepoix : Puivert, Chalabre, Camon, Lagarde, Moulin-Neuf 49 km - 3 hours - Elevation change: +313 m

Leave Quillan and ride towards Mirepoix. Discover on your way the remains of medieval castles, during Catharism period, as the castle of Lagarde, or Puivert which in a very good state of conservation. Night in Mirepoix.

Day 3: From Mirepoix to Montségur : Labastide de Bousignac, Belloc, Léran, Labastide sur l'Hers, Belesta, fontaine de Fontestorbes

46 km - 3 hours - Elevation change: +603 m

Leave the city of Mirepoix for a new destination. Ride now to the South, going through others historical sites, as the castle of Léran, build in the thirteen century. Have a break in the lake of Montbel, large water reservoir of 570 acres where you can swim. The castle of Montségur at the top its rocky spur is waiting for you, above its tiny village.

Night in Montségur.

Day 4: From Montségur to Tarascon sur Ariège: Roquefixade, Foix 51 km - 3h30 - Elevation change: +452 m

On the road to Foix, ride close to the castle of Roquefixade, on the top of the cliff. The important castle of Foix was the sign of the local power until the end of the Middle-age. It has been classified by the French authorities as an historical monument since 1840. Take your time to visit the old city of Foix before to reach Tarascon.

Night in Tarascon.

Day 5: From Tarascon sur Ariège to Comus : Bompas, Appy, Caussou 47 km - 3 hours - Elevation change: +1064 m

Ride on mountainous roads in the heart of amazing landscapes, over the "route des corniches", the cliff road. Go through small mountain villages; discover Lordat and its medieval castle or Vernaux and its chapel, built in a special calcareous stone. You approach Comus, village on the plateau of Sault. Night in Comus.

Day 6: From Comus to Axat : Niort de Sault, Joucou, Marsa 40 km - 3h - Elevation change: - 931 m

Get on you bikes to reach Nort de Sault. Cross the canyons of Rebenty and the pass of the seven brothers, at 1774 meters high. On the Roc of Niort there are some remains of a castle. Then you continue to the valley of Joucou still very wild. Night in Axat.

Day 7: From Axat to Quillan : Caudiès de Fenouillèdes, Col de St Louis and Parahou

Conclude your stay on pleasant little roads, to finish your trip in Quillan! End of the stay.

SUPERVISION:

Self guided tour :

You set off alone, equipped with the orientation equipment provided by us : detailed digital roadbook and maps with routes highlighted, to discover the circuit which has been designed by our team. You will be guided by the instructions we have carefully prepared, with the highest level of precision.

LUGGAGE TRANSPORT:

You only need to carry your personal belongings necessary for a day at a time. Bags will be transported by vehicle. Please respect the luggage limit of one bag per person, maximum weight of 15kg/bag.

ACCOMMODATION: 6 nights in hotel, guests houses or gîte on half-board formula

Double room formula: you will sleep in comfortable 2 person rooms in hotels, guest houses or gites. Sheets and towels will be provided. A bathroom will also be reserved for you at locations. (Single room option – see our website for pricing).

FOOD:

Sale contract and deposit

You'll receive the contract and the insurance policy. We'll consider the registration done when we will have received the contract signed and the deposit corresponding to 40% of the total price of your stay. Once all that is done, we'll send you a confirmation letter.

Payment of outstanding balance

Payable one month before departure. If you register less than a month before departure you'll be asked to pay the whole price at the registration.

PROCEDURES

- Passport or ID is compulsory
- We recommend to get a European Health Insurance card (check with the NHS)

DIFFICULTY LEVEL: 1.5/3

You are on good physical form and practice regularly biking, or another physical activity. Stages from 40 to 51 km by day, with medium daily positive elevation change of 1050 m.

PERIOD:

From April to October.

DEPARTURE AND MEETING POINT:

Departure from Quillan (11).

How to get there:

By car: South of France motorways A61 to Carcassonne, then N118 By train: Quillan train and bus station By plane: From Carcassonne airport, there is a shuttle to join the train station of Quillan.

THE PRICE INCLUDES:

- Booking of accommodations on half board basis, from day 1 dinner to day 7 breakfast,

INSURANCES

RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT:

Good preparation is the key to enjoying your trip. Here are some advice and equipment to help you to prepare your cycle and your bag.

2 bags: 1 small 10 litre rick sack to put the equipment for the day in (cell phone, camera, rain clothes...). 1 big bag, carried by vehicle.

LEISURE BIKE OR MOUTAIN BIKE

Be sure your bike is in good order and all these points are verified and checked:

- if you are a group bring one substitution road bike
- check your milometer
- tyres
- brakes (and brake cables)
- chain
- transmission system
- wheels
- suspension (make sure there's no leak)
- steering system

Keep in mind: a clean bike is easier to check!

REPAIRING EQUIPMENT

To avoid any mechanical problem you'll be asked to bring:

- 1 spare tyre and 1 inner tube
- 1 bicycle pump
- a puncture repairing kit
- a set of Allen keys
- a small pair of pliers
- a tyre and a piece of tyre
- a tool to take off and put back your chain

You can also take your own tool box made of:

- a brake cable
- some spokes
- a derailleur cable
- oil for the chain
- a rag
- a lock

EQUIPMENT

- helmet (essential) + cap and headband
- cycling gloves and warm gloves
- glasses
- a pair of shoes with wedges
- a pair of shorts
- T-shirt (avoid cotton ones)

BACKPACK FOR THE DAY

- water (at least 3 litres a day per person)
- high energy food or dried fruits
- your repairing kit
- a windcheater
- your picnic
- sun-cream (and lip balm)
- toilet paper and a lighter
- medicine (see below)
- 2 LR6 batteries a day (for the GPS)
- your mobile phone

PICNIC: (not included)

Bring a plastic lunchbox (to avoid any unnecessary waste) and reusable cutlery

LUGGAGE:

You'll have it back every evening at the hotel. Don't forget to bring a warm sweater, a small toilet bag, a towel, a light pair of shoes, and clothes

MEDECINE:

The instructor for guided tours will carry a first aid box but it's necessary to have at least some medicines such as:

- a mosquito repellent
- a disinfectant and gauze compresses
- Band Aid
- protection cream for your bottom
- your own pills
- water disinfectant pastilles
- a survival blanket

Don't hesitate to check with your doctor for any further information.
