

The Atlantic Coast by bike La Vélodyssée from Arcachon to Hendaye

Accommodation in hotels with 'Selected' or 'High-end' option, 6 days 5 nights including 5 days of cycling





Departing from Arcachon, set off for a trip following the Atlantic coast along the longest cycle route in France: La Vélodyssée, to Hendaye where the Basque Country awaits you.

Discover the Dune du Pilat, the most beautiful beaches in the Landes region, pine forests, the Basque coast... In the heart of perfectly preserved nature, ride at your own pace along stunning cycle paths, between dunes, beaches and forts. It is equally an opportunity to take in the renowned seaside resorts of the Atlantic coast, to taste local specialties and take a deep breath of sea air!

SCHEDULE

Day 1: Arrival in Arcachon:

Free day in the town. Take the opportunity to discover the iconic landscape of the Dune du Pilat , the highest dune in Europe. Don't hesitate to climb to its peak to take in the view over the Bassin d'Arcachon, the ocean and the forests. Settle in to your hotel in Arcachon.

Day 2: Arcachon - Biscarrosse: 50 km

Today, you set off on a great crossing of the Landaise forest; playing leapfrog with the dunes along the way. Shortly before Biscarosse beach, the Vélodyssée passes seamlessly from the Gironde into Les Landes. Warm and welcoming, gastronomy remains central to landaise traditions. Let yourself be tempted by these delights in Biscarrosse.

Day 3: Biscarrosse - Mimizan Plage: 40.5 km

This stage takes you along the banks of the Lac de Biscarrosse: a base for the assembly and testing of the largest French seaplanes. Perhaps you will be lucky enough to see some? You will also cycle between the 'étangs' (saltwater ponds) whose blue hue gradually replaces that of the sea. These are key reserves for biodiversity: protected plant, bird and mammal species. You eventually arrive at the seafront resort of Mimizan Plage.

Day 4: Mimizan Plage - Vieux Boucau: 62 km

After the liveliness of Mimizan Plage, find peace in the pine forests. Wood cut from the forest near the town is used to produce Kraft paper and packaging. This connecting stage towards the ocean provides you with the chance to take a relaxed ride in the shade of the forest whilst enjoying the odor of the pine trees. And for a change from the ocean, why not take a dip in the Lac de Léon? After, you take a gentle ride along the old Léon to Soustons railway line to arrive at Vieux Boucau.

Day 5: Vieux Boucau - Biarritz: 59 km

Night in Vieux-Boucau-les-Bains

Vieux Boucau stands at the former mouth of the River Adour and it is from here that you climb back in the saddle to follow the coast and what constitutes the longest sandy beach in Europe (106 km), ideal for lovers of sun, dips in the sea and drama! Because this is the kingdom of surf and waves! You are welcomed into the Basque country with, as always, an ocean backdrop. You reach the iconic sunshine resorts of Hossegor and Capbreton, the only fishing port in the Landes region. As you cross Bayonne, allow yourself to get lost in its streets before reaching Biarritz and its large beach.

Night in Biarritz.

Day 6:Biarritz - Hendaye: 37 km

Biarritz - one of the most prestigious seaside resorts on the Atlantic coast: with its huge beach, casino, clifftops and the Esplanade de la Vierge...head to the Marché dans les Halles where piment d'Espelette, foie gras and landaise asparagus await you. You then head south. This final stage requires a little more sporting effort, but you will be handsomely rewarded with exceptional ocean views. Cross the towns of Bidart, Guéthary (an old fishing port)...in St-Jean-de-Luz don't miss out on a walk along the lively fishing port (sardines, anchovies, tuna...). Then, the final stretch towards Hendaye. End your trip surrounded by beauty, following a superb route on the Basque

corniche, taking you down into the town and to the beachfront. End of trip in Hendaye.

Registration, deposit and validation

The registration is effective when we receive your registration form with your acceptance of the general terms and conditions of sale, accompanied by the deposit of 30% of the tour price. You will then receive an acknowledgement of receipt of your registration.



Payment of balance

The balance must be paid one month before the departure date. You will find your invoice on your My LaRébenne space, as well as a payment link to the balance of your stay.

Invitation to depart

On receipt of payment of the balance, your travel diary will be available in your customer area on My LaRébenne, where you will find all the information you need for your trip, as well as your invoice.

Insurance:

In accordance with regulations, each participant in a LaRébenne trip must hold individual civil liability as well as individual multi-risk cover to protect themselves against incidents or accidents that may occur before or during the tour or bike trip.

Assistance mainly covers search and rescue, repatriation and medical expenses. It comes into play as soon as a medical report makes it possible to decide on repatriation. Repatriation, known as "premature return", can also be arranged for reasons other than the insured's own, such as the death of a family member (see cases in the insurance booklet). Beforehand, in regions far from medical facilities and difficult to access, you must agree to the organization of first aid using local resources (4X4, porters, horses, etc.).

This contract also covers loss, theft or delayed delivery of baggage, as well as interruption of stay.

The insurance protects against the financial risk of cancellation. It is very important to have this type of

insurance in case of cancellation due to a health problem or for professional reasons.

Document valid until 03 goût 2024 CEST inclusive

We suggest you take out one of the five policies we have selected, bearing in mind that we only act as an intermediary between you and the insurer. Any additional insurance is invoiced per person and must be taken out on the day of booking:

• "Multirisque" contract (4.5%), minimum premium 15 euros: Repatriation assistance + tour interruption + luggage + cancellation.

• "Cancellation" contract (2.5%), minimum premium 10 euros: Cancellation only.
