

# Crossing of the Massif Central by road bike From the volcanoes of the Auvergne to the Mediterranean

**8 days 7 nights including 8 days of cycling, In double room and full board (picnic)**

Level: 3/5



The crossing of the Massif Central by road bike: start in Clermont-Ferrand and pass over the Auvergne volcanoes to arrive at the sea, in the pretty town of Sète, nicknamed “Venice of the Languedoc”. Cross the ‘vieux massif’ and discover, with each turn of the wheel, a variety of impressive landscapes; the Chain of Puys\*, Mont Dore, Causse Méjean (a vast limestone plateau), the Plateaus of Aubrac, the Cirque de Navacelles... These varied and peaceful mid-height mountains are perfect for road cycling. Climb the famous ‘cols’ (mountain passes) of the Tour de France 2020: Col de Ceysat, Col de Guéry, Col de Néronne or the Pas de Peyrol (the highest paved mountain pass of the Massif), or even the famous Mont Aigoual ! Last but not least, the local gastronomy is not to be missed. You will also stop off in one of the officially most beautiful villages in France: Saint-Guilhem-le-Désert.

## Strengths

- Several levels of difficulty possible for each day
- A great variety of landscapes across the Massif Central : mountain passes, forests, volcanoes, gorges and plateaus.
- A rich regional gastronomy.

- The arrival at the sea: the Mediterranean !

## Options :

- Physiotherapy: recovery session with a physiotherapist at the end of the stage
- Leader: a qualified instructor guides the group (+ sports advice)
- Mechanic: a mechanic cycles is responsible for repairs during the circuit and maintenance of the bikes at the end of the stages

## Attendees :

Individual registration:

You are 1 to 5 people: You can register on one of the dates already planned by LaRébenne in formula with assistance vehicle double room.

Group registration:

You are a group of at least 6 people: you can register on the dates planned by LaRébenne or freely on your dates (consult us) in formula lodging or double room.

## DEPARTURE AND MEETING POINT :

Appointment the first day in Clermont-Ferrand.

How to get there:

By car: Highway A75

By train: Clermont-Ferrand SNCF train station.

By plane: Clermont-Ferrand Auvergne airport.

## Accommodation :

YOUR ACCOMMODATION.

Double room formula: you sleep in comfortable rooms for 2 people in hotels \*\*, guest rooms or cottages. A private bathroom is reserved for you. Sheets and towels are provided. (Single room option - See rates).

## Difficulty level :

You are in good physical condition and go cycling on roads, over long distances, at least once a week.

Stages vary from 100 to 115km per day with positive altitude differences of 1200 to 2800m per day.

Where possible, several difficulty levels will be on offer, with the same departure and arrival points for everyone. And of course without transfers :)!

- Pedals: Rental bikes are delivered without pedals. So either bring your own pedals or let us know your pedal requirements (at least 2 weeks before the start of the tour). 3 types of pedals can be installed by us: Look KEO easy, Shimano SPD SL and Shimano SPD

- Helmet and water bottles: not included

In your booking form, please let us know the model you require, your pedal preference and your body size (including frame size and stride length if possible). Thank you very much.

You will receive your hire bike on day 1 of your tour from the tour guide (support vehicle). Bike check on handover and after the tour.

Consumables (tyres, tubes, brake pads and cables) are included in the rental price. Only parts damaged during the tour due to a fall or improper use must be replaced. In the event of theft or loss, you will be charged a lump sum (€2,200 for the standard model, €3,590 for the premium model and the e-model and €5,700 for the super light model).

## Luggage :

Formula without assistance: you only wear the items of the day, water and picnic.

Formula with assistance vehicle: you wear nothing! The assistance vehicle will delight you.

## **Accompanying :**

Self-guided cycling with assistance vehicle and driver :

The assistance vehicle with bike trailer (or bike rack) will meet you at several points throughout the day's stage, often at the top of the mountain passes (Cols) and will bring you your picnic, water, your extra clothes as well as a complete toolkit in case of any mechanical issues. As a result, you can fully enjoy your day with only a light bag or without needing to carry a bag at all. The driver will also give you advice for each stage, helping you to manage your ride and progress and will, most of the time, be able to answer any questions you may have about the local area.

Self-guided cycling with luggage transfer. (For organised group of 6+ people):

You set off alone, equipped with the orientation equipment provided by us: maps with marked routes and GPS tracks to discover the circuit which has been designed by our team. With the GPS fixed to your handlebars, you will be guided by the instructions we have carefully prepared with the highest level of precision. Contact us !

## **Food :**

Your trip might not be the best time to diet, as it's an occasion to taste the local cooking. We place great importance to the quality of the food we provide: well-balanced and nutritious, providing lots of energy with the specialties of the region incorporated into each meal.

- Your accommodations provides Continental breakfasts.
- We distribute simple cereal/muesli bars and dried fruit in the morning before the start of the stage.
- Hearty dinners (3 to 4 courses, with local dishes)
- You must bring your own specific energy bars and isodrinks.

At lunch, there is 2 options based on what you prefer :

- A picnic to carry along in a small backpack. It contains an individual salad (carbohydrate and vegetable based salad), cold meats, cheese and fruit. This picnic can be carried in a small backpack or a handlebar bag.
  - No lunch organised by us, leaving you free to stop and eat when and where you want (restaurant, bakery, grocery store...).

### Registration, deposit and validation

Once you've chosen your trip, it's quick and easy to register!

The registration is effective when we receive your registration form with your acceptance of the general terms and conditions of sale, accompanied by the deposit of 30% of the tour price. You will then receive an acknowledgement of receipt of your registration.

### Payment of balance

The balance must be paid one month before the departure date. You will find your invoice on your My LaRébenne space, as well as a payment link to the balance of your stay.

### Invitation to depart

On receipt of payment of the balance, your travel diary will be available in your customer area on My LaRébenne, where you will find all the information you need for your trip, as well as your invoice.

### Insurance :

In accordance with regulations, each participant in a LaRébenne trip must hold individual civil liability as well as individual multi-risk cover to protect themselves against incidents or accidents that may occur before or during the tour or bike trip.

Assistance mainly covers search and rescue, repatriation and medical expenses. It comes into play as soon as a medical report makes it possible to decide on repatriation. Repatriation, known as "premature return", can also be arranged for reasons other than the insured's own, such as the death of a family member (see cases in the insurance booklet). Beforehand, in regions far from medical facilities and difficult to access, you must agree to the organization of first aid using local resources (4X4, porters, horses, etc.).

This contract also covers loss, theft or delayed delivery of baggage, as well as interruption of stay.

The insurance protects against the financial risk of cancellation. It is very important to have this type of insurance in case of cancellation due to a health problem or for professional reasons.

We suggest you take out one of the three policies we have selected, bearing in mind that we only act as an intermediary

between you and the insurer. Any additional insurance is invoiced per person and must be taken out on the day of booking:

- "Multirisque" contract (4.5%), minimum premium 15 euros:  
Repatriation assistance + tour interruption + luggage + cancellation.
