



TOWING SAFETY CHECKLIST

1. Make sure the handle's safety pin is properly installed.
2. Equip the safety chains.
3. Plug in the trailer's wiring harness and breakaway switch.
4. Close the tow vehicle's tailgate.
5. Remove any chocks around the wheels.
6. Retract the trailer jacks.
7. Test the trailer lights.
8. Perform a gentle pull test to ensure that everything is properly attached.

Remember:

Driving with a trailer is different than driving without one. The best thing you can do is slow down.
