

New Graduate Rotation Program

The Lee Health Rotation Program is a perfect opportunity for the new graduate Physical Therapist to get additional mentorship, training, and experience in a variety of therapy settings all in a fulltime, fully salaried and benefited position.

Lee Health Rotator Therapists have the opportunity to gain experience in the following care settings:

- Acute Care

Rotations are four to six months in length. Each rotator is assigned a mentor and receives accentuated orientation and clinical support, starting primarily as an observer and picking up their own caseload (with oversight) as competence and comfort level in that setting increases. The expectation is that by the end of the four to six-month rotation, the rotator is able to function independently with a full case load in that setting.
