


### REMOVING THE KEYBOARD DRAWER

**TIP:** Temporarily remove the keyboard drawer before assembling the lectern.

- 1. Slide keyboard drawer out from unit and press tab to release it from the drawer slides. (**FIGURE A**)
- 2. Reverse this process for installation/re-installation.

#### NOTE:

- When re-installing drawer, ensure the slide bearing is fully towards the front, then carefully slide in drawer allowing it to properly sit.
- Improper installation may damage the slide bearing.



3. At this point, if you purchased a drawer option, install drawer sliding rails before proceeding. (**FIGURE B**)

**NOTE:** Install side panels prior to installing drawer. Refer to "Installing Side Panels" on page 12, for more information.







### REPOSITIONING CONNECTIVITY PANEL/ACCESSORY PANEL (IF PURCHASED)

#### FOR TURRET FRAME MODELS ONLY:

- The connectivity panel is pre-installed inside turret frame.
- This topic shows you how to reposition your pre-installed connectivity panel, if needed.
- Similarly, an accessory panel can be repositioned following the steps listed below.





1. Remove (4x) pre-installed screws securing connectivity panel to frame and remove from frame.

**NOTE:** Connectivity panel door gap faces outside edge of frame. (**FIGURE C**)

 Install connectivity panel on desired mounting location in a reverse manner, as shown. (FIGURE D)

#### **INSTALLING MIDDLE PANEL**

• Install Middle Panel (N) using (6x) #10 x ¾" wood screws (E) and (6x) spacers (D). (FIGURE E)



#### **INSTALLING KEYBOARD DRAWER PANEL**

**NOTE:** The hardware kit for the keyboard drawer panel handle differs based on your purchased finishing kit.

1. Install keyboard drawer panel (M) on pre-installed hinges. (FIGURE F)

2. Install handle (U or V) on keyboard drawer using (2x) Pan Head Screws (S or T).

**NOTE:** There are (3x) hinge catches located at the top of the frame as shown.

3. Adjust hinges as needed. (FIGURE G)





4. Install (2x) self-adhesive rubber bumpers (A) for keyboard drawer panel over frame holes as shown. (**FIGURE H**)




#### **INSTALLING FRONT DOORS**

NOTE: The hardware kit for the door handle differs based on your purchased finishing kit.

- 1. Install front door(s) (G) on preinstalled hinges.
- 2. Install handle(s) (U or V) on door(s) (G) using (2x) Pan Head Screws (S or T). (**FIGURE J**)
- 3. Install (4x) rubber bumpers (B) (2x) per door in locations shown. (**FIGURE K**)

4. If necessary, use a #2 Phillips screwdriver to adjust door hinges as shown. (**FIGURE L**)



#### **INSTALLING WORKSURFACE**

**NOTE:** Worksurface mounting holes are identified with a white ring on underside of frame top support to help locate holes.

### FOR FLAT FRAME MODELS ONLY:

There are (5x) alignment slots and (2x) mounting hole locations at the top of frame, as shown. (**FIGURE M**)

#### FOR TURRET FRAME MODELS

**ONLY:** There are (3x) alignment slots and (2x) mounting hole locations at the top of frame, as shown.




- 1. Locate alignment slots and mounting hole locations on your frame model.
- 2. Open keyboard shelf drawer.
- 3. Align worksurface (F) on top of frame with standoffs facing down and contoured edge facing the keyboard side of lectern. (**FIGURE N or P**)
- 4. Flush side of worksurface to side of frame.

- 5. Pull worksurface forward approximately 2" (50.8 mm) to ensure the standoffs drop into alignment slots.
- Push worksurface back to allow standoffs to lock into the frame alignment slots.
- 7. Secure worksurface from inside of frame using (2x) #10 x ¾" wood screws (E) into pre-drilled mounting holes in worksurface.



#### **INSTALLING SIDE PANELS**


**NOTE:** If you purchased the optional L5 flip-up side shelf, refer to the L5 Flip-Up Side Shelf instruction sheet (I-00818) at www.legrandav.com prior to installing side panels.


- 1. Place the (6x) pre-installed hooks into the (6x) slots on frame and press panel down to lock in place. (**FIGURE R**)
- 2. Secure panel to frame using (2x) #10 x %" wood screws (C).
- 3. Repeat previous steps to secure the second side panel.




- 1. Assemble top shelf (K) to top shelf bracket (supplied with frame) using (6x) #10 x 5/8" wood screws (C). (FIGURE S)
- 2. Install assembled top shelf to side panels using (4x) #10 x 5%" wood screws (C) (2x) per side. (FIGURE T)

## INSTALLING STORAGE DRAWER PANEL OPTION (IF PURCHASED)

• The optional storage drawer is available for all frame sizes.

• This topic shows how to attach the storage drawer panel (P) supplied with your wood kit, to the pre-installed storage drawer.


1. Remove pre-installed storage drawer from frame.

2. Install handle (U or V) to storage drawer panel (P) using (2x) pan head screws (S or T). (**FIGURE V**)

3. Install assembled storage drawer panel (P) to drawer using (6x) #10 x 5/8" wood screws (C).

4. Re-install storage drawer into frame.

**NOTE:** When drawer is installed and side panel is in place, it may be necessary to adjust gap around drawer panel by slightly loosening wood screws (C). Once adjusted, re-tighten wood screws.

#### INSTALLING DOCUMENT CAMERA DRAWER PANEL OPTION (IF PURCHASED)


This topic shows how to attach the document camera drawer panel (R) supplied with your wood kit,

to the document camera drawer.

 With drawer removed, install camera drawer panel (R) using (6x) #10 x <sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" wood screws. (FIGURE W)

2. Install handle (U or V) using (2x) pan head screws (S or T).

3. Re-install drawer in frame.
When drawer is installed and side panel is in place, it may be necessary to adjust gap around drawer panel by slightly loosening wood screws (C). Once adjusted, re-tighten wood screws.



## **INSTALLING PRESENTER PANEL (TURRET FRAME MODELS ONLY)**

Install presenter panel (W) using (6x) 10-32 x ¾" truss head screws included with panel.





#### **INSTALLING REAR PANEL**

- 1. Install rear panel (J) by placing the (8x) pre-installed hooks into the (8x) slots on the frame and press down to lock in place. (**FIGURE Y**)
- 2. Reinstall keyboard shelf to complete assembly.

**NOTE:** For security, rear panel can be locked in place using pre-installed lock located on the top shelf of the turret frame models and located along the back edge of the worksurface on the flat frame
