Comprehensive Tattoo Aftercare

Remove the Bandage: After 2-4 hours, in a clean environment, gently remove the bandage.

Wash Your Hands: Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water.

Cleanse the Tattoo: Gently wash the tattoo with mild soap and water to remove any excess ointment, ink, or dried blood.

Dry Gently: Pat the tattoo dry with a clean, dry towel or use paper towels.

Apply "Hustle Butter": After allowing the tattoo to air dry for 15 minutes, apply a small amount of "Hustle Butter" or a similar tattoo-specific ointment.

Daily Cleaning: Wash your tattoo at least twice a day, especially if it becomes sweaty or dirty.
