NOTE - To comply with regulations, installation must be carried out by suitably qualified competent person and in accordance with the current IEE Wiring Regulations (BS7671) and Building Regulations. A copy of the instructions must be left for the user/maintenance engineer for future reference.


- Luminaire is not suitable for use with blanket insulation NOTE - 75mm airspace shall be left around the luminaire
- This product is only suitable for indoor use
- This product must be disconnected before insulation resistance testing of the lighting circuit
- Check for electrical cables and pipes before installation

INSTRUCTIONS FOR NEW INSTALLATIONS

- 1. With a suitable mounting position identified, carefully cut the recommended cutout based on the model you are installing. Details can be found in the above table
- 2. The modules are supplied with a remote driver. Connect to the electrical supply cable, observing the correct polarity. (Live=Brown & Neutral= Blue) NOTE- as a class II product, no earth connection

is used/required

- **3.** Connect the module to the driver using the push fit connector. Twist the connector to secure
- 4. Push the springs upwards and offer the module up to the ceiling. The springs will retract and hold the downlight in the ceiling
- 5. The product can be rotated up to 350° and tilted up to 30°
- 6. Once installed restore the power and test operation






Cutout - 125mm X 125mm
