




Commute Highlights



Environmental Factors

The climate data below highlights environmental factors that Gypsum, Colorado faces from climate change in the coming years. The risk scores are based on the latest modeling data from climate scientists, universities, and federal agencies.

About 18.61% of buildings in Gypsum have a significant flood risk. A typical building with flood risk in this area has about a 31% chance of a flood over about **71.1"** deep before 2050.

The percentage of available water supply used by humans determines water stress. An area is at especially high risk when water stress is above 40%.

The water stress for Gypsum is currently about 22.67%. In 2050 it is predicted that the amount of water stress will be around 25.17%.

Normally, about 0.68% of land near Gypsum burns in a year, or about 214 sq. miles within a 100-mile radius. The forecast projects that by 2050 the number will change to about 1.08% of land or **339 sq. miles** per year.
