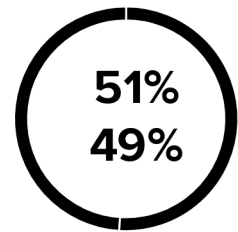

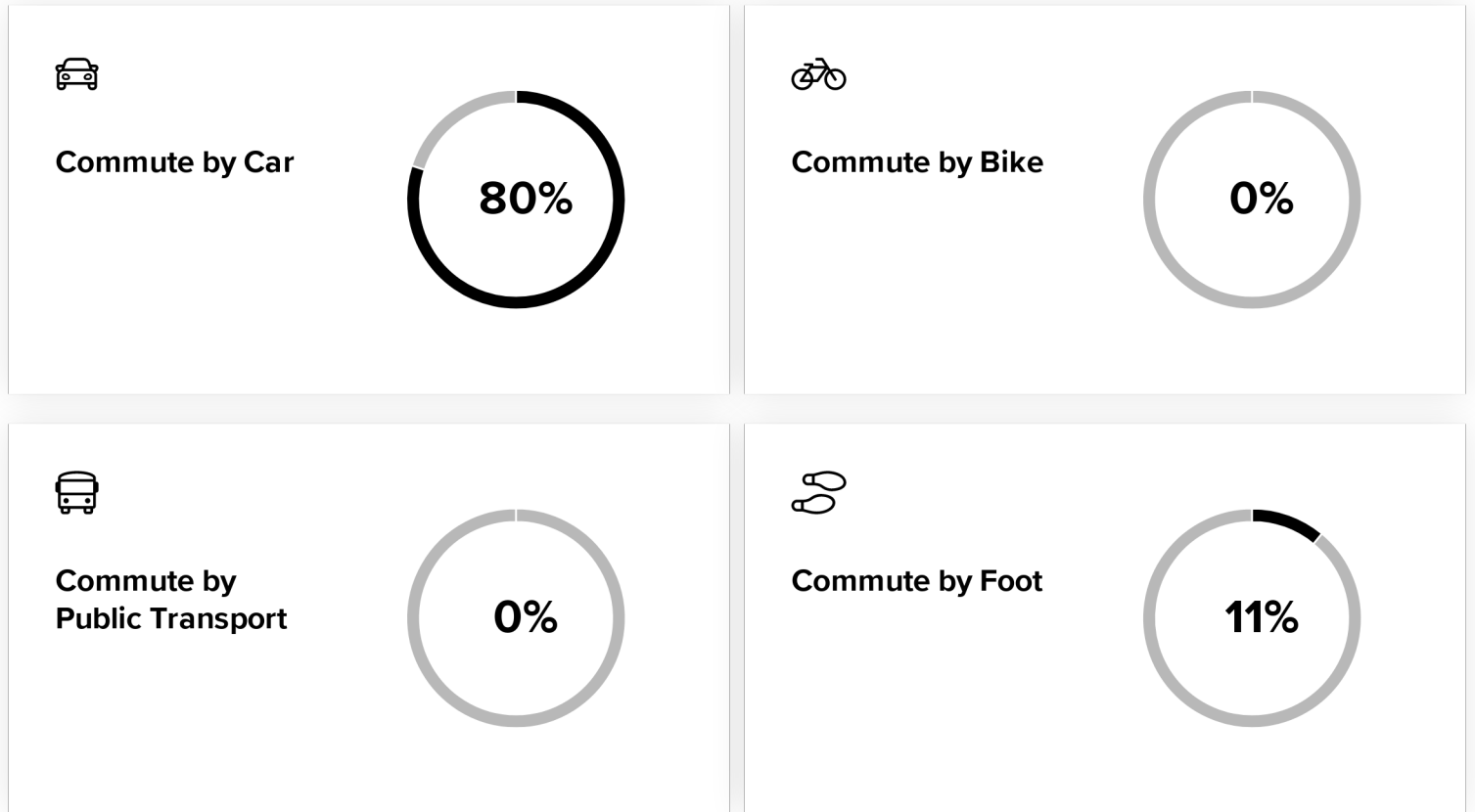

Commute Highlights

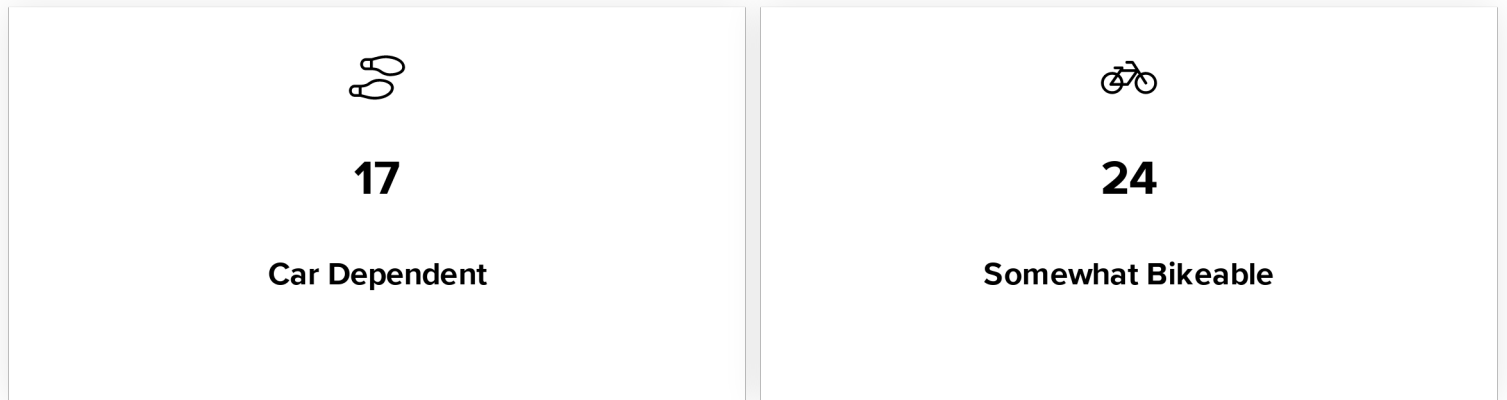

Environmental Factors

The climate data below highlights environmental factors that Avon, Colorado faces from climate change in the coming years. The risk scores are based on the latest modeling data from climate scientists, universities, and federal agencies.



The average risk due to climate change for this area is high.



Flood

High **62%**

About **14.72%** of buildings in Avon have a significant flood risk. A typical building with flood risk in this area has about a **25%** chance of a flood over about **69.6"** deep before 2050.



Storm

High **64%**

Normally, you experience about **8** significant 2-day storms per year, with about **0.81"** of precipitation per storm.

Normally, you experience about **24** significant 2-day storms per year, with about **0.97"** of precipitation per storm.



Heat

High **63%**

A day that reaches **81°F** is considered hot for Avon.

Normally, you experience about **8** hot days per year. The forecast for 2050 is about **43 hot days** per year.



Drought

Moderate **47%**

The percentage of available water supply used by humans determines water stress. An area is at especially high risk when water stress is above 40%.

The water stress for Avon is currently about **22.69%**. In 2050 it is predicted that the amount of water stress will be around **25.19%**.



Fire

High **66%**

Normally, about **2.32%** of land near Avon burns in a year, or about **727 sq. miles** within a 100-mile radius. The forecast projects that by 2050 the number will change to about **4.28%** of land or **1342 sq. miles** per year.
