

Pulaski County's Most Expensive Home Sales of 2021

ales of luxury homes in Pulaski County shattered records in 2021, resulting in Arkansas Business changing the way it tracks million-dollar home sales.

Arkansas Business increased the floor price of the homes it follows from \$1 million to \$1.25 million because 67 homes sold for \$1 million or more in 2021. In 2020, 47 homes sold for \$1 million or more, up from 34 homes that sold for seven figures in 2019.

In 2012, the low point in our survey, just 13 million-dollar homes sold.

"We are in a historic market that began to surge during the pandemic," Jon Underhill, who sells upscale homes through his own agency in Little Rock, said via email to Arkansas Business. "Homes valued at \$1 million, or more, are a lot more common. Due to rising incomes and historically low borrowing cost, the number of people who can afford a million-dollar home has increased."

Last year, 32 homes sold for \$1.25 million or

Underhill projects the "red-hot" housing market will continue this year. Homes have sold within hours of being listed and "frequently for well over the asking price," he said.

In this market, homebuyers have no qualms about going above the listing price. "High demand and low inventory create a very competitive market where buyers sometimes find themselves in a bidding war," Underhill said. "A higher offer may be the only way to stand out and secure the home."

Another factor that could be driving the housing market is that people from out of state are moving to Arkansas, said Sarah Bailey, owner

and principal broker of Pixel Properties Realty of Little Rock, a real estate agency. "We have had quite a few out-of-state clients," she said. (Bailey also bought a house that appears on this year's list of most expensive homes purchased in Pulaski County.)

Underhill said that some of the key

features that people are asking for in an upscale home are location, followed by a floor plan that works for their family.

"Amenities that high-end buyers are seeking include high-end kitchens, spa bathrooms, pool and outdoor kitchens with entertainment areas," he said.

Energy-efficient homes have been a bonus for some buyers, but that emphasis hasn't been a deciding factor for Underhill's higher-end clients.

Luxury homes are selling quickly. Last year, the average number of days that a seven-figure home was on the market was 42.

Underhill said that last week there were 23 homes listed for sale at or above \$1 million in Pulaski County. "However, I always have a list of

> higher-end homes that sellers are not quite ready to actually list, but are willing to sell," he said.

Built by renowned Little Rock homebuilder Jack Hartsell, the house features an 80,000-gallon pool and a "distinctive free standing 3-story elliptical foyer staircase," Zillow said. Curtis Howse is an executive vice president of Synchrony Financial and CEO of its home and auto division. Synchrony, of Stamford, Connecticut, is a consumer financial services company. He previously led Synchrony's direct to consumer division for Synchrony Bank, an online banking platform with more than \$63 billion in deposits, according to a company news release.





Build Houses, **Build Wealth**

rkansas Business' annual issue on the most expensive homes sold in central and northwest Arkansas in the previous year is perennially popular. This year it contains real news: Sales of \$1 million-plus homes have been so numerous that we've had to raise our floor to be placed on the list to \$1.25 million, the first time since we began publishing the list, which at the time focused only on central Arkansas, in 2005.

Jon Underhill, who sells upscale homes through his Little Rock agency, calls it "a historic market" boosted by rising incomes and historically low borrowing costs.

In northwest Arkansas, the market has also been assisted by the region's solid employer base and quality of life. As Kristen Boozman, owner of Portfolio Sotheby's International Realty in Rogers, noted, homebuyers coming from expensive housing markets elsewhere in the U.S. see Arkansas housing as cheap.

But there's a sour note in this symphony of residential splendor, at least for northwest Arkansas: Housing is becoming increasingly unaffordable for low-

and middle-income families.

Regional leaders realize there is a problem. In September, the Walton Family Foundation recommended measures to address the area's housing crunch. Among them: zoning ordinance changes that would allow more efficient review of developmental plans, lower administrative costs and more diverse planning, including greater housing

For middle-income families, home ownership remains a way to build generational wealth, the kind that allows children to benefit from their parents' hard work and good decisions and build even better lives for themselves. Spending by middle-income families enables the enormous success of the region's businesses. Their work as teachers, nurses, police officers, firefighters and more is essential to the area's well-being.

For northwest Arkansas' prosperity to be sustainable, affordable housing must be a priority.

Standard Lithium Bets Big on State

rkansas Business, led by energy reporter Kyle Massey, has been following the story of Arkansas lithium since 2018, when a Vancouver company few had heard of began optioning brine lands and detailing extraction plans in south Arkansas.

The company, Standard Lithium Ltd., aims to source lithium from the underground brine that other companies are already mining for bromine near Magnolia and El Dorado. Lithium is a key ingredient in batteries powering the devices at the center of our personal and professional lives: cellphones, computers, airplanes and, increasingly, electric vehicles. As Massey pointed out in an early story, lithium carbonate is also a common treatment for bipolar disorder and other illnesses.

Phase one of Standard's plan was to prove that its novel method of lithium extraction — one that would be faster and less wasteful than current methods — could work. The next phase was to build a test extraction facility at the Lanxess Corp. bromine plant in El Dorado. Lanxess has partnered with Standard Lithium nearly from the beginning, and now has a significant equity stake in the startup, a key vote of confidence in its prospects.

Another vote of confidence came from a well-known global investor: the Koch Strategic Platforms arm of Koch Investments Group, a subsidiary of Charles Koch's Koch Industries of Wichita, Kansas. And it wasn't until last week that we got a better understanding of Koch's interest in the Arkansas project.

As Massey reported in November, Koch Strategic Platforms made a \$100 million direct investment in Standard, and signaled possible collaborations with other Koch companies, including Koch Engineered Solutions and Koch Minerals & Trading.

David Park, Koch Strategic Platforms' CEO, said at the time that his firm "is focusing on investing in companies with strong tailwinds that are disrupting the market as we know it," and that he expects the investment to "help accelerate the production of lithium resources right here at home." The company listed half a dozen ways the investment could complement existing operations at other Koch companies.

A few months later, Koch's overall strategy is coming into focus. As The Wall Street Journal reported on Tuesday, the Standard Lithium stake is one of several investments Koch is making in the U.S. battery supply chain and electric vehicles. Yes, the conglomerate whose CEO has, as the Journal notes, "long opposed environmental regulation and funded groups that questioned

climate change" is now a major backer of electric vehicle batteries. In fact, the Journal, examining company filings, news releases and other data, cites analysts who say Koch's battery investments "are among the biggest from outside the auto industry."

According to the Journal, Koch is investing in companies that aim to:

- Make better batteries (Solid Power Inc. of Louisville, Colorado, and Aspen Aerogels of Northborough, Massachusetts).
- ▶ Make cheaper, more sustainable batteries (Freyr Battery SA of Norway, with which Koch has a manufacturing joint venture in the U.S.).
- ▶ Provide raw materials for batteries (Li-Cycle Holdings Corp. of Mississauga, Canada, and Standard Lithium).

So that's the big picture. A global conglomerate born from the oil industry is, like other big companies, investing more money domestically in greener, more sustainable forms of energy. But zooming in on Arkansas, the exciting story is that a big company has put \$100 million into a plan that adds a potentially lucrative new dimension to a 60-year-old bromine industry that few of us think much about.

Standard and its investors have a long way to go and, as Massey reported earlier this month, some are questioning the company's production claims. But there's also at least one other company, Galvanic Energy LLC of Oklahoma City, with designs on starting its own lithium operation in south Arkansas, another vote of confidence in Standard's strategy.

I'm happy to see more investment in domestic control of key technologies like electric vehicle batteries. The pandemic and Russia's invasion of Ukraine have highlighted the degree to which we rely on other countries for all kinds of critical goods and services. It's well worth considering the things we can do domestically to strengthen our hand, especially when it comes to the technologies of tomorrow, given the global unknowns we face. ■
