

You can enter Park either from the top $(5^{\rm th})$ floor, or from the Lungomare on the level 0. 



Art in Park



Rovinj is a town which should be seen from the sea, and my first glimpse of it was indeed from the water. I perceived a sea that was transparent and at the same time dense, imagining multifariously coloured reflections. Reflections which helped me understand the mellow quality of the town's colours, the movement of the sea rendering my photography ever more fluid. My photos are pure and simple narratives that occasionally verge on the extreme, because, if photography is by definition recording with light, my photos record worlds of unexpected horizons with light.

Technique

The name of the work derives from the technique with which it was made, called sand casting, in which simple sea sand is held in a frame in which the IMPRESS creates objects, the ones that we borrowed from nature and our surroundings. This becomes the negative mold in which the concrete is cast. The low relief that comes out of it maintains the natural softness of the sand forms and the robust rawness of the cement.


Description

The eight decorative panels tell the beauty of Rovinj by stylised shapes and symbols seen during my trip there.

The first panel starts with the arrival: the vibrant light of the sea between the trees gives way to the ancient map of the town with its small streets, illuminated by the light of the sun pushing soft shades.

The bell tower of St. Euphemia is the centre of the work around which all of the elements revolve, appear and fade back into the sand.

PREDRAG TODOROVIĆ — ROVINJ DIARIES For me, Rovinj has always been an experience of the forces of nature tamed with an indescribable mildness and gentleness. I see the present architectural solution for the new Grand Park Hotel Rovinj as an effort to elevate and highlight the beauty and strength of this natural world. Thematically, my painting reliefs from the cycle entitled "Impressed" deal with sensations and experiences that leave a mark on our subconscious minds. Artistically, their final appearance also suggests the elemental strength of the forces of nature and the traces of their footprints over millions of years. The paintings achieve a harmonious accord with the space of this contemporary architecture and assist in creating a calm and harmonious atmosphere for guests and visitors. In artistic and technical terms, the painting reliefs are, not only artistically, but also conceptually defined by the process of their execution. As part of that process, various segments of reality are captured – framed by a reinforcing mesh. Gypsum lime plaster is then poured onto a particular segment to which, as the last layer, canvas is mounted. Finally, all of these layers are stretched onto a frame. This process is a complete inversion of the standard approach to constructing a painting. Here, the painting has actually happened before we have even had a chance to fix it in our minds.

I imagined and executed the soundscape of Grand Park Hotel Rovinj relying on its interior and exterior spaces. The sounds appear and waken from afar, through colour, texture and volume changes, it repeatedly and tirelessly appears and disappears. The sound shapes the air and inhabits the space itself, it invokes the state of total awakening in us, and enhances the silence of the space. The sound is made of elements that complement each other. Long reverb sounds of a grand piano, electric guitar, kalimba or paraphonic analogue synthesiser interweave with the field recordings form Rovinj's area. The sea's ripple effect mixes with its wave field lines, mild winds in bamboo leaves with local people's conversations. These meeting points form sound junctions, places where audio paths cross. Aside from the comprehensive soundscape in the lobby and the Wellness and Spa area, there are also hidden micro sound locations that call the guest to gradually discover the space, simultaneously forming his own inner landscape.



MARKO TADIĆ — ROVINJ DIARIES In the creation of the Hotel Park works, I was inspired by vintage postcards of Rovinj. In the process of creating this, I used these postcards as living material and combined them with my drawings and collages. In these works, we can see these wonderous places we feel we already know, yet want to explore more of.


KLARA RUSAN — ROVINJ DIARIES Rovinj in the winter is a totally different story than Rovinj in the summer. While strolling up and down the Old town of Rovinj, my attention was caught by local people and animals in their typically slow Croatian tempo which usually speeds up (a little) during summer months filled with tourists. For someone like me, who lives in the city, this experience of Rovinj was a sight for sore eyes, music to my ears and rhapsody of taste for my mouth.

I spent two days in Rovini for the first time in my life. And, I was lucky enough to catch its magic during two very different days. The day I arrived, it was raining and the streets were empty. It was foggy and humid, but still very lovely. It was mysterious and gentle at the same time, due to the town's colour pallette. I walked everywhere, observing the architecture, windows, materials, small details. I enjoyed smells of the sea, forest and "grandma's cooking". I wrote down all my impressions. The next day, sunshine woke me up. I went out and walked to the main square. It was like being in a different city. Streets and terraces were crowded with people, I heard seagulls, people talking in Italian, English, Croatian... Everything was alive and full of life. Colours were brighter, and everything seemed faster. I sat in one of the café bars with my sketchbook. I eavesdropped and wrote dialogues, I sketched a few people or wrote the description of the situations. When I came back to Zagreb, I gathered all of those sentences and sketches and made drawings. It was so easy, almost natural. I used ink, pencils, coloured pencils, watercolor. I imagined people enjoying Rovinj and then going back to their rooms in the Grand Park Hotel. I asked myself, what did they do in the town? What was their favorite thing to do or, what caught their eye the most? Did they have a routine? And I combined the answers with my own impressions for the final drawings, enjoying every minute of making them.



DANIJEL SRDAREV — ROVINJ DIARIES Drawings created for the Grand Park Hotel Rovini have been inspired by Rovinj, its hidden streets with picturesque details, as well as its rich cultural heritage. During my stay in Rovinj, aiming at the inspiration for the drawings created for the hotel, I tried as much as possible to discover and bring to life hidden and interesting locations. Many sketches were created for that occasion and they were used for my final drawings. The drawings have the character of a traveler's diary which I have been creating for the past ten years during my travels, trying to accomplish such impression for the realisation of this assignment, emphasizing what is important and not ignoring the personal impression of this experience. The bell tower of St. Euphemia is an inevitable mark and, at the same time, the most recognisable picture of Rovini, as well as the numerous palaces in the old part of town. In these drawings, I have tried to take the traveller through the hidden streets, pointing them out with abstract motives using visual and verbal notes in order to make the traveller explore, discover and self-discover their own Rovinj. My intention was to make an impression of the traveller who makes notes of some kind of the essence of this experience, transferring that on a sketch paper, making short notes in order to achieve the impression of the slow passing of time, while bearing in mind some other times when that was a tradition and not an exception. Throughout the series of drawings,

I have tried to leave enough freedom for each traveller to experience their own Rovinj, which will stay in their memory, and Rovinj, with its beauty, will definitely encourage them to discover more and come back to it, as well as to themselves, in the confusing and fast-paced world of today, in which there isn't enough time for those essential things. The technique I used in the series of drawings for Grand Park Hotel Rovinj is ink on paper with some collage and colour interventions.

With St. Euphemia as a beacon of sorts, you will always find your way home whatever side of Istria you venture to. And venture you should.

A B O U T R O V I N J The view from the Grand Park is what initially sets it apart from other hotels. It is positioned just across the bay from the Old town, with St Euphemia church and St Katarina Island as its focal points. Have a look through the window; this is one of the most recognizable vistas in the Adriatic. Did you know that Rovinj was once called Mons Rubeus (Red Hill)? One theory says that the name came from the red colour of the town's rooftops. But, when you witness the moments when the town bathes in crimson sunset light, you will know which answer we prefer. Rovinj is definitely as exciting to experience as it is to look at. It is one of those places that manages to combine its rich and long history with modern times. The old town speaks many hidden stories that span over 1200 years of history. Rovinj is also an active fishing port, where you can experience the atmosphere of a small fishing village. The town at the foot of St Euphemia church is the favorite gathering place of artists from all around the world. Walking down its streets, you will find many art galleries and studios, whilst once a year, in August, you can attend the largest open-air exhibition of the Adriatic coast, which takes place in one of the main streets of the Old town – Grisia.

A R O U N D R O V I N J ROVINJ ARCHIPELAGO The islands and the coastal strip are special landscape protection areas. Moreover, the entire coast around Rovinj is also a nature reserve, as well as the 22 islands and islets that surround it. There are many stories lurking from every corner, the most striking being the story of the death of the wealthy Venetian doge, a legend associated with the lighthouse island of St. John. If you are not interested in history though, you can simply enjoy hidden beaches and coves dotted along the coast.

THE LIM BAY For something unexpected, head north from Rovinj to the Lim Bay, a unique formation in the whole of Adriatic. After enjoying the scenery of this 12-kilometres long fjord, opt for oysters that you can eat straight from the sea.

PALUD MARSH ORNITHOLOGICAL RESERVE For more of the natural wonders, the ornithological reserve Palud is an interesting marsh area about 10 kilometers from Rovinj. Fresh and salt water, as well as marsh vegetation, provide a unique refuge and retirement for many swamp dwellers – more than 200 bird species, turtles, eels – and great photo opportunities.

ISTRIA

If you want to spend a day outdoors, explore Istria's interior and purposely get lost on its roads that cut through its famous hilly countryside.

The medieval towns dotted on hills' tops – Motovun, Buzet, Grožnjan – are inviting stops for a tired traveller, offering great food and beverage options on every corner. Istria's hardworking people turned its red soil into eco farms, vast vineyards and truffle hunting forests. Istrians' close connection to nature is best seen in Istria's gastronomy and people's respect for quality dining. Just cruising on its backroads and trying the hard-to-find traditional *oštarijas* can bring you a surprise gastro experience.
