THE EAST CUT

The East Cut has forged a new identity in recent years and is San Francisco's fastest-growing and most exciting new neighborhood. The East Cut, which covers about seven square blocks is San Francisco's first high-rise, dense, walkable neighborhood. It includes several of San Francisco's most luxurious glass condominium towers, and home to large offices for companies such as Facebook, LinkedIn and Salesforce.

The centerpiece of the neighborhood is the 5.4-acre Salesforce Park, an elevated green space built atop a bus terminal and reachable by elevator or gondola from below. The park is a quiet reprieve from the high-rises that surround it, with grassy lawns and curving paths. There's plenty of programming as well, from yoga classes to toddler play groups.

With newly designed pedestrian plazas and streetscapes, and the East Cut's central location — adjacent to SOMA and the financial district, it is easily the neighborhood people are flocking to.
