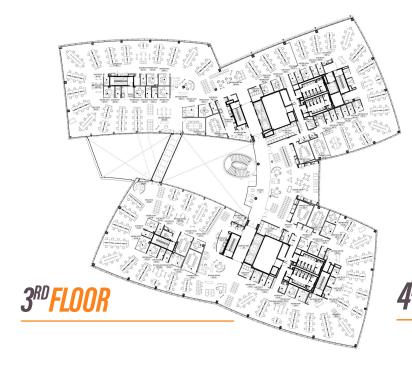

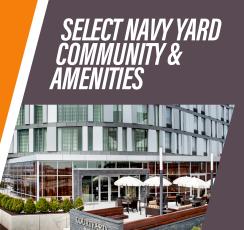

#### Navy Yard Philadelphia

Widely considered the most successful redevelopment of a former military facility in the country, and with 5 million square feet of mixed-use development including, housing, biosciences, office, retail and hospitality underway as of 2021, the Navy Yard is undoubtedly Philadelphia's most dynamic live-work-play-stay community.

The Navy Yard's total employment has steadily increased by approximately 1,000 new employees per year and will support an additional 10 million square feet of commercial and residential development at full buildout.
