ICONIC ARCHITECTURE

Originally opened in 1917, the Union Trust Building is an 11-story Flemish Gothic structure designed by famed architect Frederick J. Osterling. It features a central rotunda with a stained-glass dome and a mansard roof adorned with terra cotta dormers and two towers.
