The newly landscaped waterfront plaza gives tenants a place to unwind, meet with colleagues and friends, and enjoy lunch inside or outside.

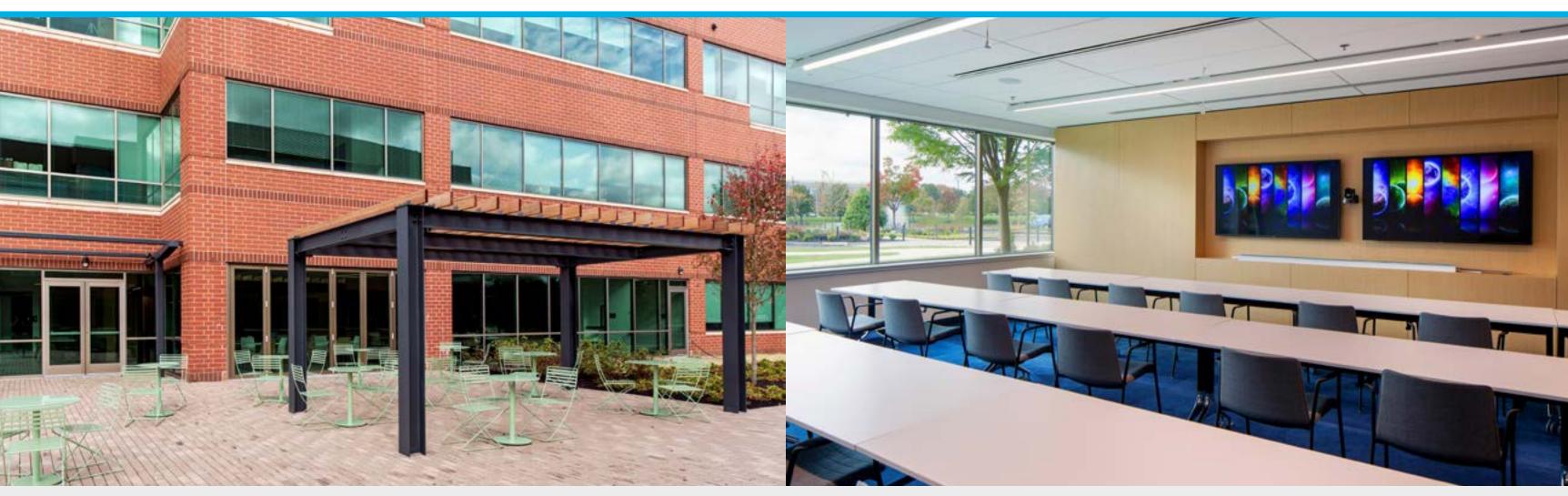

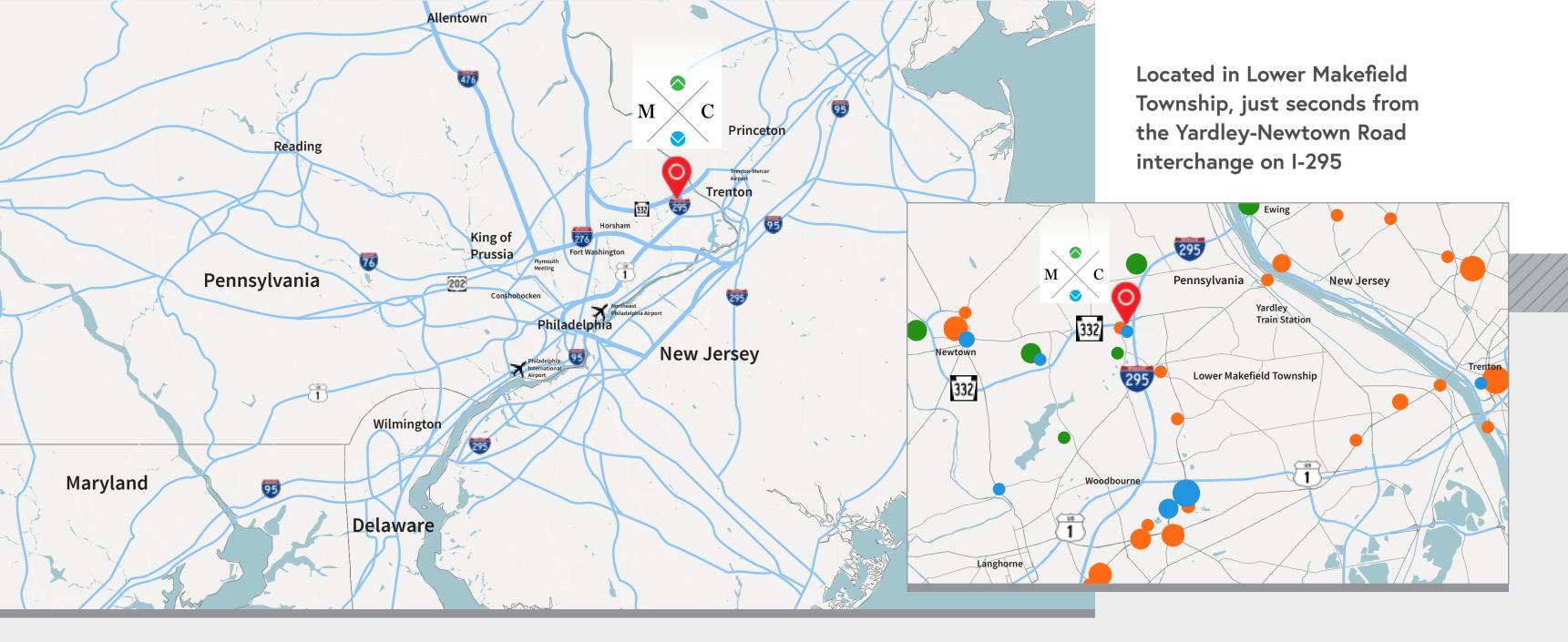
